# 1 Description of Service

- 1.1. The <u>CDSP</u> is responsible, under the <u>UNC</u>, for maintaining the register of (amongst other things) gas <u>Supply Meter Points</u> and gas <u>Market Participant Data</u>. Where this data is required under this <u>Code</u>, it is generally provided via the <u>Gas Retail Data</u> Service to the <u>Central Switching Service</u>, as described in the <u>GRDS Service Definition</u>.
- 1.2. The <u>CDSP</u> also performs a number of further services to support processes under this <u>Code</u> under contract to <u>RECCo</u> (and not governed by the <u>UNC</u>). These further services are defined in this <u>Service Definition</u> document.
- 1.3. These further services comprise:
  - (a) provision of monthly reports regarding the validation of meter data updates in accordance with the <u>Metering Operations Schedule</u>;
  - (b) provision of an annual reconciliation activity comparing meter data held in the <u>Central Gas Register</u> and data held by individual gas <u>Metering Equipment Managers</u> in accordance with the <u>Metering Operations Schedule</u>; and
  - (c) provision of historic market share data to enable reconciliation of unallocated payments made via a <u>Prepayment Meter</u> in accordance with the <u>Prepayment Arrangements Schedule</u>.
- 1.4. Each of these further services is described in more detail below.
- 1.5. The format of the data provided by the <u>Code Manager</u> to <u>CDSP</u> and reports to be provided by the <u>CDSP</u> to the <u>Code Manager</u>, and the mechanism by which they are to be sent, is described in <u>RECCo</u>'s contract with the <u>CDSP</u>.



# 2 Centralised reporting of meter data updates

- 2.1. The <u>CDSP</u> shall provide reports on ONJOB, ONUPD and K08 transactions, as specified in the REC <u>Data Specification</u>, to the <u>Code Manager</u>.
- 2.2. The <u>CDSP</u> shall compile reports on a monthly basis in relation to each individual <u>Gas Supplier</u> as recorded within the <u>Central Gas Register</u>.
- 2.3. The reports will be provided by the 10th Working Day of each month for all transactions completed in the previous calendar month.
- 2.4. For the monthly reports on ONJOB transactions, the <a href="CDSP">CDSP</a> shall report, in respect of each <a href="Gas Supplier">Gas Supplier</a>, the total count of ONJOB transactions received within a calendar month, plus the percentage of those ONJOB transactions which were accepted and the percentage which were rejected.
- 2.5. For the monthly reports on ONUPD transactions, the <u>CDSP</u> shall report, in respect of each <u>Gas Supplier</u>, the total count of ONUPD transactions received within a calendar month, plus the percentage of those ONUPD transactions which were accepted and the percentage which were rejected.
- 2.6. For the monthly reports on K08 transactions:
  - (a) the <u>CDSP</u> shall report, in respect of each <u>Gas Supplier</u>, the total count of K08 transactions received within a calendar month, plus the percentage of those K08 transactions which were accepted and the percentage which were rejected; and
  - (b) for the accepted K08 transactions, the <u>CDSP</u> shall report on the total count of K08 transactions received within 4 <u>Working Day</u>s of the <u>Effective From Date</u> of the <u>Metering Equipment Manager</u>.
- 2.7. The <u>Code Manager</u> will be the only direct recipient of the service described in this Paragraph 2. Data contained within the reports shall be provided by the <u>Code Manager</u> to the <u>REC PAB</u> where requested. Data may also be provided by the <u>Code Manager</u> to individual <u>Gas Suppliers</u> or published on the <u>REC Portal</u> as determined by the <u>REC PAB</u>.

#### 3 Meter data reconciliation activity

- 3.1. The <u>CDSP</u> shall perform an annual comparison exercise between the data provided directly by each gas <u>Metering Equipment Manager</u> and the data held within the <u>Central Gas Register</u>.
- 3.2. As part of such annual comparison exercise, the CDSP shall:
  - (a) verify that the asset data provided by the <u>Metering Equipment Manager</u> accords with that recorded in the Gas Central Register; and
  - (b) verify that the Gas Supplier that has appointed the Metering Equipment Manager



accords with that recorded in the Gas Central Register.

- 3.3. In accordance with the <u>Metering Operations Schedule</u>, each gas <u>Metering Equipment</u> <u>Manager</u> takes an annual snapshot, on 1 April, of the required <u>Data Items</u> and provides the data to the <u>CDSP</u>.
- 3.4. Where the data described in Paragraph 3.3 is not received by the <u>CDSP</u> in accordance with the timing and format requirements of the <u>Metering Operations Schedule</u>, the <u>CDSP</u> shall identify the non-compliant Meter Equipment Managers to the <u>Code</u> Manager for escalation in accordance with the <u>Performance Assurance Schedule</u>.
- 3.5. The <u>CDSP</u> shall perform a comparison between the data received from gas <u>Metering Equipment Managers</u> and the data recorded in the <u>Central Gas Register</u>. The <u>CDSP</u> shall report to the <u>Code Manager</u> on the outcome of such comparison within 75 <u>Working Day</u>s following each 1 April. The report will detail the number and type of asset discrepancies in relation to each <u>Gas Supplier</u>.
- 3.6. Within 75 Working Days following each 1 April, the CDSP shall also:
  - (a) provide a report to each <u>Gas Supplier</u> detailing the asset discrepancies identified in relation to <u>RMP</u>s for which the <u>Gas Supplier</u> is the <u>Registered Supplier</u>; and
  - (b) provide a report to each Metering Equipment Manager in respect of its own data.
- 3.7. The <u>Code Manager</u> shall provide data from the reports under Paragraph 3.5 to the <u>REC PAB</u> on request.
- 4 Provision of historic market share data for Prepayment Meters
- 4.1. In this Paragraph 4, participant Gas Suppliers are <u>Gas Suppliers</u> who had a contract with the <u>PPMIP</u> in the reporting period defined in the <u>Prepayment Arrangements</u> <u>Schedule</u> (being July Y-5 to June Y-4, where Y is the year in which the report is run).
- 4.2. Where required, in accordance with the <u>Prepayment Arrangements Schedule</u>, the <u>Code Manager</u> shall notify the <u>CDSP</u> of the MPID of the Participant Gas Suppliers in the format agreed.
- 4.3. The <u>CDSP</u> shall report to the <u>Code Manager</u> setting out each Participant Gas Supplier's <u>Prepayment Meter</u> market share over the reporting period. This market share value will be based on the number of <u>Supply Meter Points</u> with a <u>Prepayment Meter</u> for which each Participant Gas Supplier was <u>Registered Supplier</u>, as a percentage of the total number of <u>Supply Meter Points</u> with a <u>Prepayment Meter</u>.
- 4.4. The <u>CDSP</u> shall provide the report within 10 <u>Working Day</u>s following a valid request from the <u>Code Manager</u> under Paragraph 4.2.
- 4.5. The <u>CDSP</u> shall retain the information used to compile the report for only 3 months after delivery of the report.
- 4.6. The <u>Code Manager</u> shall be the only direct recipient of the service under this Paragraph 4. The <u>Code Manager</u> shall only use the data to determine the share of



<u>Unallocatable Transaction</u>s to be allocated to each Participant Gas Supplier under the <u>Prepayment Arrangements Schedule</u>.

# **5** Service Levels

- 5.1. Each service to be delivered by the <u>CDSP</u> within this <u>Service Definition</u> has been defined as a distinct service with associated reporting timescales, as set out in Paragraphs 2, 3 and 4. The <u>Code Manager</u> shall report to the <u>REC PAB</u> on any delays against defined timescales.
- 5.2. Where the <u>CDSP</u> is unable to provide specific reports within the timescales defined in this <u>Service Definition</u>, the <u>CDSP</u> shall contact the <u>Code Manager</u> prior to the reporting deadline and agree a revised reporting schedule. In the case of reports under Paragraph 3, the <u>CDSP</u> shall also inform the individual <u>Gas Supplier</u> and <u>Metering Equipment Managers</u> of any delay.
- 5.3. Where the <u>CDSP</u> and the <u>Code Manager</u> cannot agree a revised timescale for provision of delayed reports, the issue will be escalated to the <u>REC PAB</u>.

# 6 System audit

6.1. Subject to Paragraph 4.5, the reports generated pursuant to this <u>Service Definition</u> shall be retained by the <u>CDSP</u> and the <u>Code Manager</u> for 12 months.

## 7 Data handling

7.1. The services described within this <u>Service Definition</u> shall be capable of receiving information related to all gas <u>Supply Meter Points</u>.
