#### PART A - General Provisions

#### 1 Introduction

- 1.1. The <u>Green Deal</u> arrangements aim to promote the efficient use of energy in a way which protects the interests of <u>Consumers</u>, promotes effective competition between <u>Electricity Suppliers</u> and promotes effective competition between <u>Green Deal Providers</u>.
- 1.2. This <u>REC Schedule</u> describes the arrangements for parties that are involved in the <u>Green Deal</u> arrangements, covering:
  - (a) the arrangements for becoming a Green Deal User;
  - (b) the end-to-end processes for establishing <u>Green Deal Plans</u> and managing ongoing updates;
  - (c) the collection of <u>Green Deal Charges</u> through electricity bills by <u>Mandatory Green</u> <u>Deal Suppliers</u> and <u>Voluntary Green Deal Suppliers</u>; and
  - (d) the remittance of <u>Green Deal</u> payments to <u>Green Deal Providers</u> or their nominees.
- 1.3. This <u>REC Schedule</u> should be read in conjunction with the <u>GDCC Service Definition</u>, which describes:
  - (a) the internet portal used to provide access to <u>Green Deal Arrangements Data</u> for <u>Green Deal Users</u>; and
  - (b) the interactions with <u>Green Deal Users</u>, <u>EPC Registers</u> and the <u>Electricity Enquiry</u> <u>Service</u> in order to maintain the <u>Green Deal Arrangements Data</u> within the <u>Green Deal Central Charging Database</u> (GDCC).
- 1.4. <u>RECCo</u> shall contract with a service provider for provision of the <u>GDCC Service</u> consistent with the description set out in the <u>GDCC Service Definition</u>. Where necessary, <u>RECCo</u> shall exercise its rights under the service provider contract to ensure that the contract remains consistent with the <u>GDCC Service Definition</u> and this <u>REC Schedule</u>.



- 1.5. Each <u>Electricity Supplier</u> shall take all steps within its control to ensure that <u>RECCo</u> complies with its obligation under Paragraph 1.4.
- 1.6. Changes to this <u>REC Schedule</u> and the <u>GDCC Service Definition</u> shall be progressed in accordance with the REC Change Management Schedule.
- 1.7. Words in this <u>REC Schedule</u> which begin with a capital letter and which are not defined in the <u>Interpretations and Definitions Schedule</u> shall have the meaning given to them in the <u>Green Deal Framework Regulations</u>.

#### **2** Green Deal Arrangements Agreement

- 2.1. The <u>Green Deal Framework Regulations</u> establish a scheme to make provision for certain matters relating to the <u>Green Deal</u>.
- 2.2. Regulation 24 of the <u>Green Deal Framework Regulations</u> requires each <u>Green Deal Provider</u> to enter into and comply with an agreement (referred to in the <u>Green Deal Framework Regulations</u> as the <u>Green Deal Arrangements Agreement</u>) as a condition of its authorisation.
- 2.3. This <u>REC Schedule</u>, together with the other parts of this <u>Code</u> with which <u>Green Deal Users</u> are obliged by their <u>Access Agreements</u> to comply, comprises the <u>Green Deal Arrangements Agreement</u> referred to in the <u>Green Deal Framework Regulations</u>.
- 2.4. Condition 38 (<u>Green Deal Arrangements Agreement</u>) of the <u>Electricity Supply Licences</u> provides that there shall be an agreement between those electricity supply licensees who are mandatory or voluntary participants in the <u>Green Deal</u>, all <u>Green Deal Providers</u> and such other persons as are appropriate parties for payment and remittance purposes or continuity purposes.
- 2.5. This <u>REC Schedule</u>, together with the parts of this <u>Code</u> which apply in relation to the <u>Green Deal</u>, comprises the <u>Green Deal Arrangements Agreement</u> referred to in the <u>Electricity Supply Licences</u>.

#### PART B - Green Deal Users



- 2.6. For the purposes of Condition 38 of the Electricity Supply Licences:
  - (a) persons who intend to be assigned the right to receive <u>Green Deal Charges</u> are capable of being appropriate parties to this <u>REC Schedule</u> for payment and remittance purposes; and
  - (b) the objective of this <u>REC Schedule</u> is that as outlined in Paragraph 1.1 save that the words "promotes effective competition between <u>Green Deal Providers</u>" are excluded.
- 3 Becoming a Green Deal User
- 3.1. Organisations wishing to participate in the <u>Green Deal</u> arrangements shall become a <u>Green Deal User</u> in accordance with this Part B.
- 3.2. Once an organisation has become a <u>Green Deal User</u>, all rights and obligations set out in this <u>REC Schedule</u> shall apply until such time as the organisation ceases to be a <u>Green Deal User</u> in accordance with Paragraph 6.
- 3.3. Green Deal Users are categorised as follows:
  - (a) Electricity Suppliers;
  - (b) Green Deal Providers;
  - (c) Green Deal Finance Parties;
  - (d) Green Deal Remittance Processors; and
  - (e) <u>Distribution Network Operators</u> acting in their capacity as <u>MPAS Providers</u>.

#### **Green Deal User Application Process**

- 3.4. An application to become a <u>Green Deal User</u> includes three separate processes:
  - (a) for:
- (i) an organisation that is eligible to become a <u>Party</u> to this <u>Code</u>, Qualification in accordance with the <u>Qualification and Maintenance Schedule</u>; or



- (ii) an organisation that is not eligible to become a <u>Party</u> to this <u>Code</u>, entry into an <u>Access Agreement</u> in accordance with the <u>Qualification and Maintenance Schedule</u>;
- (b) establishing access to the <u>Data Transfer Network</u>, including accession to the <u>Data Transfer Services Agreement</u>; and
- (c) establishing the required <u>Green Deal User Data</u> in accordance with the process set out in Paragraph 3.8 onwards.
- 3.5. The <u>Code Manager</u> shall only approve an application from a potential <u>Green Deal User</u> if, at the date of its completed application:
  - (a) in the case of admission as an <u>Electricity Supplier</u>, the applicant holds an <u>Electricity Supply Licence</u>; and
  - (b) in the case of admission as a <u>Green Deal Provider</u>, the applicant holds a <u>Green Deal Provider Authorisation</u>;
  - (c) in the case of admission as a Green Deal Finance Party, the applicant is either:
    - (i) a bank or financial institution or a trust, fund or other entity, which is regularly engaged in or established for the purpose of making, purchasing or investing in loans, securities or other financial assets; or
    - (ii) a <u>Green Deal Provider</u> who is engaged in or established for the purpose of making, purchasing or investing in loans, securities or other financial assets:
  - (d) in the case of admission as an <u>Green Deal Remittance Processor</u>, either Paragraph 3.6 or 3.7 applies to the applicant; and
  - (e) in the case of admission as <u>Distribution Network Operator</u>, the applicant holds an <u>Electricity Distribution Licence</u>.

#### Designating a **Green Deal Remittance Processor**

3.6. Where an organisation wishes to become a <u>Green Deal Remittance Processor</u> only, a <u>Green Deal Provider</u> or <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u> who is a <u>Green Deal User</u> in that role, must confirm to the <u>Code Manager</u> that the organisation applying to become a <u>Green Deal Remittance Processor</u> is to act for them in this role.



3.7. Any organisation wishing to become both a <u>Green Deal Provider</u> or <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u> and a <u>Green Deal Remittance Processor</u> may do so subject to the conditions on <u>Green Deal Provider</u> applications in Paragraph 3.4.

#### Process for establishing Green Deal User Data

- 3.8. Each <u>Green Deal User</u> required to exchange <u>Market Message</u>s with the <u>GDCC</u> shall have a set of data associated to it within the <u>GDCC</u>, and this shall determine the routing of <u>Market Messages</u>. This <u>Green Deal User Data</u> shall comprise:
  - (a) <u>Market Participant Identifiers</u> (<u>MPIDs</u>), associated <u>Market Participant Role</u> <u>Code</u>(s) and associated effective date(s) as entered in <u>Market Domain Data</u> in accordance with the BSC;
  - (b) applicable bank account details;
  - (c) for <u>Green Deal Providers</u>, their associated <u>Green Deal Remittance Processors</u>;
  - (d) for <u>Green Deal Remittance Processors</u>, their associated <u>Green Deal Provider(s)</u>; and
  - (e) details of the Green Deal User's Green Deal Plans.
- 3.9. The <u>Code Manager</u> shall ensure that the data referred to in Paragraph 3.8 is maintained for each <u>Green Deal User</u> and incorporated within the overall <u>Green Deal Arrangements Data</u> within the <u>GDCC</u>. The Paragraphs below define the process for maintaining <u>Green Deal Arrangements Data</u> mastered by the <u>Code Manager</u>.

## Creation of a new <u>Market Participant Identifiers</u> and <u>Market Participant Role</u> <u>Code</u>s

- 3.10. As part of the process to become a <u>Green Deal User</u>, each new <u>Green Deal Provider</u>, <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u> and/or <u>Green Deal Remittance Processor</u> shall establish a new <u>Market Participant Identifier</u> within the <u>BSC Market Domain Data</u>.
- 3.11. Existing <u>Market Participants</u> may add new <u>Market Participant Role Code</u>s to existing <u>Market Participant Identifiers</u> in the following scenarios:



- (a) the addition of a <u>Green Deal Provider</u> and/or <u>Green Deal Remittance</u> <u>Processor</u> Role Code to an existing <u>Market Participant Identifier</u>; or
- (b) the addition of the <u>Green Deal Licensee</u> Market Role Code to a <u>Market Participant Identifier</u> already associated with an <u>Electricity Supplier</u> who is a <u>Mandatory Green Deal Licensee</u> or a <u>Voluntary Green Deal Licensee</u>.
- 3.12. Where an <u>Electricity Supplier</u> is adding the <u>Green Deal Licensee</u> Role Code, it must be added to all <u>Market Participant Identifiers</u> for that organisation that have a Market Role Code for the <u>Electricity Supplier</u> role as defined in <u>Market Domain Data</u>.
- 3.13. The process to be used to add new <u>Market Participant Identifier</u>s and Market Role Codes is as follows:

## **Process for Establishing / Updating Bank Account Details**

- 3.14. There are two different types of bank account details held in the <u>GDCC</u> in order to allow for the remittance of monies in various circumstances, specifically for:
  - (a) remittance of Green Deal Plan Charges to <u>Green Deal Remittance Processors</u>; and
  - (b) payment of reclaimed monies to Green Deal Licensees in respect of Green Deal



Plan Charges.

- 3.15. These details must be provided to the <u>Code Manager</u> prior to a new <u>Green Deal User</u> being able to send and receive <u>Market Message</u>s. This information is sent to relevant <u>Green Deal Users</u> as part of the <u>Green Deal Arrangements Data</u>.
- 3.16. Where new bank account details are submitted, any existing details will be end-dated to the date before the new details take effect.
- 3.17. Any new or updated details should be provided to the <u>Code Manager</u> via the following process:

## **Green Deal Provider to Green Deal Remittance Processor(s)**

- 3.18. In order to ensure the correct routing of information to <u>Green Deal Remittance Processors</u> that are acting as agents for one or more <u>Green Deal Providers</u> or <u>Green Deal Finance Parties</u>, the <u>Green Deal Arrangements Data</u> contains all such associations and the <u>GDCC</u> will only permit routing of data to valid <u>Green Deal Remittance Processors</u> based on this association.
- 3.19. The <u>Green Deal Provider</u> or <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u> is responsible for the provision of these details as set out below:

#### **End-dating of Information**

- 3.20. There will be occasions where a <u>Green Deal User</u> will wish to end date certain data in the <u>Green Deal Arrangements Data</u>. The items that may be end-dated are:
  - (a) the association between a given <u>Market Participant Identifier</u> and a Market Role Code; and
  - (b) the association between a <u>Green Deal Provider</u> or <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u>, and a Green Deal Remittance Processor.
- 3.21. Any requested end date must be equal to or greater than the next available go-live date for an update to the <u>Green Deal Arrangements Data</u>.
- 3.22. Where a Market Role Code is end-dated for any given Market Participant Identifier, any related bank account details will be end-dated to the same date.
- 3.23. Where an organisation ceases to be a <u>Green Deal User</u> without having requested the updating of their <u>Green Deal Arrangements Data</u> records to reflect the fact, the <u>Code Manager</u> shall raise a request to <u>BSCCo</u> to end date the relevant record(s) in <u>MDD</u> and amend the <u>Green Deal Arrangements Data</u> such that the overall record is end dated in line with the publication of the relevant <u>MDD</u> update.
- 3.24. Where a <u>Green Deal User</u> wishes to end date a particular association, they should follow the process below:

## 4 Appeals by Green Deal Applicants

- 4.1. For an organisation which applies to become a Green Deal User in any capacity:
  - (a) appeals can, in the first instance, be made to the <u>REC PAB</u> in accordance with the <u>Qualification and Maintenance Schedule</u>; and
  - (b) if the applicant is dis-satisfied with the decision of the <u>REC PAB</u>, or if no decision is communicated to the applicant within 25 <u>Working Days</u> of the applicant appealing the matter to the <u>REC PAB</u>, then the applicant may apply to court for a resolution.

#### 5 Undertakings by **Green Deal Users**

- 5.1. Each Green Deal User shall remain a party to the Data Transfer Services Agreement.
- 5.2. Each <u>Electricity Supplier</u> and <u>Green Deal Provider</u> shall maintain in full force and effect all required authorisations at all times, namely:



- (a) in the case of an Electricity Supplier, an Electricity Supply Licence; and
- (b) in the case of a Green Deal Provider, a Green Deal Provider Authorisation.
- 5.3. A <u>Green Deal Provider</u> shall immediately notify the <u>Code Manager</u> if the <u>Green Deal Provider</u>:
  - (a) makes an application for the withdrawal of its <u>Green Deal Provider</u> <u>Authorisation</u> pursuant to Regulation 17 of the <u>Green Deal Framework Regulations</u>;
  - (b) is notified by the Secretary of State whether any application made by the <u>Green Deal Provider</u> pursuant to Regulation 17 of the <u>Green Deal Framework Regulations</u> is granted or refused;
  - (c) receives notice pursuant to Regulation 72 of the <u>Green Deal Framework</u> <u>Regulations</u> that the Secretary of State is minded to withdraw the provider's <u>Green Deal Provider Authorisation</u>; or
  - (d) has its <u>Green Deal Provider Authorisation</u> withdrawn by the Secretary of State pursuant to Part 8 of the <u>Green Deal Framework Regulations</u>.
- 5.4. Subject to the objective of this <u>REC Schedule</u> (as stated in Paragraph 1.1) each <u>Green Deal User</u> shall conduct its marketing activities in connection with the <u>Green Deal</u> in a fair, transparent, appropriate and professional manner.
- 5.5. A Green Deal User's breach of this Paragraph 5 shall constitute an Event of Default.
- 6 Ceasing to be a Green Deal User

#### **Green Deal Providers**

- 6.1. A <u>Green Deal Provider</u> shall cease to be a <u>Green Deal User</u> where its <u>Accession Agreement</u> is terminated (or ends in so far as applicable to the <u>Green Deal</u> arrangements).
- 6.2. A <u>Green Deal Provider</u> cannot validly give notice to terminate its <u>Access Agreement</u> (or to end its application to the <u>Green Deal</u> arrangements) unless and until its <u>Green Deal Provider Authorisation</u> is withdrawn pursuant to either Regulation 17 or Part 8 of



the Green Deal Framework Regulations

## **Electricity Suppliers**

- 6.3. An Electricity Supplier shall cease to be a Green Deal User where:
  - (a) it ceases to be a Party to this Code; or
  - (b) if it is a <u>Voluntary Green Deal Supplier</u> and it is not an agent and trustee under s1(6) of the Energy Act 2011 for any <u>Green Deal Provider</u>, on the <u>Electricity Supplier</u> giving 15 <u>Working Days'</u> notice in writing to the <u>Code Manager</u>.

#### **Green Deal Finance Parties**

- 6.4. A <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u> shall cease to be a <u>Green Deal User</u> where its <u>Access Agreement</u> is terminated (or ends in so far as applicable to the <u>Green Deal arrangements</u>).
- 6.5. A <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u> cannot validly give notice to terminate its <u>Access Agreement</u> (or to end its application to the <u>Green Deal</u> arrangements) unless and until there are no <u>Nominated Green Deal Plans</u> in force in relation to that <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u>.
- 6.6. If at least 6 months have elapsed since there was at least one Nominated Green Deal Plan in force in relation to a Green Deal Finance Party, then the Code Manager may terminate the Green Deal Finance Party's Access Agreement (insofar as relating to the Green Deal arrangements) by giving at least 15 Working Days' notice to the Green Deal Finance Party.

#### **Other Green Deal Users**

6.7. For those <u>Green Deal Users</u> which are not <u>Electricity Suppliers</u>, <u>Green Deal Providers</u> or <u>Green Deal Finance Parties</u>, they shall cease to be a <u>Green Deal User</u> where their <u>Access Agreement</u> is terminated (or ends in so far as applicable to the <u>Green Deal</u> arrangements).

#### 7 Access to the **Green Deal Arrangements Data**



- 7.1. <u>Green Deal Arrangements Data</u> is available to <u>Green Deal Users</u> via a web interface, as described in the <u>GDCC Service Definition</u>. Accessible data items are based on the Green Deal User Category and reflected in the <u>Data Access Matrix</u>. Arrangements for amending the <u>Data Access Matrix</u> are as set out in the <u>Data Access Schedule</u>.
- 7.2. <u>Electricity Suppliers</u>, <u>Green Deal Providers</u>, <u>Green Deal Finance Parties</u>, <u>Green Deal Remittance Processors</u>, <u>Distribution Network Operators</u> and <u>MPAS Providers</u> will only be able to view data for periods for which they are (or were) the party carrying out defined activities in relation to that data, specifically:
  - (a) with the exception of <u>Green Deal Charges</u>, an <u>Electricity Supplier</u> shall only be permitted to view data relating to <u>Green Deal Plan</u> records for periods for which it is (or was) the <u>Registered Supplier</u> for the associated <u>Metering Point</u>;
  - (b) a <u>Green Deal Provider</u>, <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u> or <u>Green Deal Remittance Processor</u> shall only be permitted to view data relating to <u>Green Deal Plan</u> records for periods during which they are (or were) associated with that <u>Green Deal Plan</u> record in the <u>GDCC</u>; and
  - (c) a <u>Distribution Network Operator</u> or <u>MPAS Provider</u> shall only be permitted to view data relating to those <u>Metering Points</u> for which it is responsible, based on the element of the <u>Meter Point Administration Number</u> that identifies the relevant <u>Distribution Network Operator</u>.
- 7.3. Each <u>Green Deal User</u> shall only be entitled to access data from the <u>GDCC</u> for the purposes of performing its obligations and exercising its rights under this <u>REC</u> Schedule, the Data Transfer Services Agreement and its Green Deal Plans.

#### 8 Misuse

- 8.1. Access to and use of the <u>GDCC</u> database shall be monitored by the <u>Code Manager</u>, and any activity that raises concerns as to the intent of an individual or group of <u>Green Deal User</u>s shall be escalated to the <u>REC Performance Assurance Board</u>.
- 8.2. Where any suspected use of the <u>GDCC</u> in breach of this <u>REC Schedule</u> comes to the attention of the <u>Code Manager</u>, the <u>Code Manager</u> shall investigate such suspected misuse and, where appropriate, report its findings to the <u>REC Performance Assurance Board</u>.



- 8.3. Each <u>Green Deal User</u> shall co-operate with such investigations, including making records available and permitting access to business sites where necessary.
- 8.4. The <u>REC Performance Assurance Board</u> shall determine appropriate action in accordance with the <u>Performance Assurance Schedule</u>, which at its sole discretion may include notification of appropriate action and a timescale for remedy to the relevant <u>Green Deal User</u>, failing which the <u>REC Performance Assurance Board</u> may disable access for one or more <u>Green Deal User</u> personnel.

#### 9 GDCC Terms of Use

- 9.1. Each <u>Green Deal User</u> shall (and shall ensure that its <u>Authorised Person</u>s) only use the <u>GDCC</u> for the purpose permitted in accordance with Paragraph 7.3.
- 9.2. Except as authorised by Clause 18 (Confidentiality) of the main body of this <u>Code</u>, or otherwise for the purposes of the <u>Green Deal</u> only, the <u>Green Deal User</u> shall not make available to any other person or publish or otherwise exploit modify or create derivate works from or combined with any other material in whole or in part of the <u>Green Deal Arrangements Data</u> that it may access via the <u>GDCC</u> from time to time (but excluding its own <u>Green Deal User Data</u>).
- 9.3. Each <u>Green Deal User</u> hereby undertakes that it will treat all <u>Green Deal Arrangements Data</u> (other than <u>Green Deal User Data</u>) as confidential and further undertakes that it will limit access to and use of <u>Green Deal Arrangements Data</u> on a strictly "need to know basis" for the purposes permitted in accordance with Paragraph 7.3 only.

#### 9.4. Each Green Deal User shall:

- (a) limit access and use of the <u>GDCC</u> to <u>Authorised Person</u>s only, and supervise and control access to and use of the <u>GDCC</u> by <u>Authorised Person</u>s in accordance with this <u>REC Schedule</u>;
- (b) take all necessary steps to ensure that its employees, agents and subcontractors do not act or omit to act in such a way that would cause the <u>Green Deal User</u> to breach this <u>REC Schedule</u>;
- (c) not display any part of the <u>GDCC</u> or <u>Green Deal Arrangements Data</u> on a public bulletin board, ftp (File Transfer Protocol) site, world wide web site, chat room or



by any other unauthorised means;

- (d) ensure that <u>Authorised Person</u>s are:
  - (i) informed of and are contractually bound to safeguard the confidential nature of the GDCC Data in accordance with this REC Schedule; and
  - (ii) competent in the use of the <u>GDCC</u> prior to use of the <u>GDCC</u> and understand the rights and obligations imposed in accordance with this <u>REC Schedule</u>; and
- (e) have the business controls in place that are necessary to ensure compliance with this Schedule.

#### 9.5. No Green Deal User shall:

- (a) knowingly introduce to the <u>GDCC</u> any viruses, Trojans, worms, logic bombs or other material that is malicious or technologically harmful;
- (b) attempt to gain unauthorised access to the <u>GDCC</u>, the server on which the <u>GDCC</u> is stored or any server, computer or database connected to the <u>GDCC</u> (including via the <u>Data Transfer Network</u>); or
- (c) attack the <u>GDCC</u> via a denial-of-service attack or a distributed denial-of service attack.
- 9.6. Each <u>Green Deal User</u> shall promptly notify the <u>Code Manager</u> if the <u>Green Deal User</u> becomes aware of any unauthorised or unlawful processing of, loss of, damage to, destruction or corruption of, or misuse of any <u>GDCC</u> Data, or of any security breach that could compromise the security or integrity of the <u>GDCC</u> and/or the <u>GDCC</u> Data or otherwise adversely affect the <u>GDCC</u> or any one or more <u>Green Deal Users</u> (including that passwords have or are suspected to have been disclosed or obtained).
- 9.7. RECCo shall not be liable under or in connection with this REC Schedule for:
  - (a) any delay or failure of a <u>Green Deal User</u> to receive or obtain (in each case in whole or in part) any <u>GDCC</u> Data;
  - (b) any loss or damage substantially caused or contributed to by failure of any systems which interface with the <u>GDCC</u> and which cause any <u>GDCC</u> performance or availability failure, including (i) the <u>Data Transfer Network</u>;



and (ii) interfaces between the GDCC and the EPC Registers;

- (c) any corruption, omission, error, inaccuracy, incompleteness, unreliability, lack of currency or lack of updating of or in any <u>GDCC</u> Data provided, supplied, received or obtained pursuant to this Agreement; or
- (d) any loss or damage caused by a distributed denial-of-service attack, viruses or other technologically harmful material that may infect the <u>Green Deal User</u>'s computer equipment, computer programs, data or other proprietary material due to the <u>Green Deal User</u>'s use of the <u>GDCC</u> or to the <u>Users</u> use of or uploading of any <u>GDCC</u> Data.

#### 10 Additional Legal Provisions

#### **Data Protection Requirements**

- 10.1. Paragraphs 10.2 to 10.8 apply in addition to Clause 19 (Data Controller Obligations) and Clause 20 (Data Processor Obligations) of the main body of this <u>Code</u>.
- 10.2. Each <u>Green Deal Provider</u> undertakes to provide or make available (as appropriate), at such time as is required by the <u>Data Protection Legislation</u>, a <u>Fair Processing Notice</u> on its own behalf and on behalf of other <u>Data Controllers</u> which will be processing <u>Personal Data in connection with the relevant Green Deal Plan</u>, including to:
  - (a) each <u>Improver</u> with whom it has agreed to a quotation concerning a proposed Green Deal Plan;
  - (b) each first <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> (who is not the <u>Improver</u>) in respect of a <u>Green Deal Plan</u> which the <u>Green Deal Provider</u> has entered into; and
  - (c) each <u>Default Bill Payer</u> in respect of a <u>Green Deal Plan</u>, other than a <u>Nominated</u> Green Deal Plan, with that Green Deal Provider,
- 10.3. but only if those <u>Improvers</u>, <u>Green Deal Bill Payers</u> or <u>Default Bill Payers</u> (as appropriate) are <u>Data Subjects</u>.
- 10.4. Each <u>Electricity Supplier</u> undertakes to provide or make available (as appropriate), at such time as is required by the <u>Data Protection Legislation</u>, a <u>Fair Processing Notice</u> to each of its <u>Consumers</u> who becomes a <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> (after the first <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u>) in respect of a <u>Green Deal Plan</u>, but only if those <u>Consumers</u> are <u>Data Subjects</u>.



- 10.5. Each <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u> undertakes to provide or make available (as appropriate), at such time as is required by the <u>Data Protection Legislation</u>, a <u>Fair Processing Notice</u> on its own behalf and on behalf of other <u>Data Controllers</u> processing <u>Personal Data</u> in connection with the relevant <u>Green Deal Plan</u> to each <u>Default Bill Payer</u> in respect of a <u>Nominated Green Deal Plan</u> which has been transferred to that <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u>, but only if those <u>Default Bill Payers</u> are <u>Data Subjects</u>.
- 10.6. For the avoidance of doubt, the obligations in Paragraphs 10.2 to 10.4 may be satisfied by <u>Electricity Suppliers</u>, <u>Green Deal Providers</u> or <u>Green Deal Finance Parties</u> (as appropriate) incorporating the <u>Fair Processing Notice</u> into any other notice they provide to their <u>Consumers</u> in connection with the processing of <u>Personal Data</u>.
- 10.7. It is acknowledged that in providing the GDCC for each Green Deal User, RECCo (via its REC Service Provider) may act in the capacity of a Data Processor on behalf of that Green Deal User. Where this is the case, Clause 20 (Data Processor Obligations) applies. The Personal Data which the GDCC Operator processes as a Data Processor on behalf of Green Deal Users will be the Personal Data which is included within Green Deal User Data. The purpose of such processing is to provide the Green Deal arrangements described in this REC Schedule. The full description of the subject matter, nature and purpose of the processing, and the type of personal data is described in Appendix 1.
- 10.8. Each <u>Green Deal User</u> undertakes that it shall not process any personal data collected by another participant in the <u>Green Deal</u> in connection with the <u>Green Deal</u> for any purposes other than performing its obligations and exercising its rights under this <u>REC Schedule</u> and/or the <u>Data Transfer Services Agreement</u> or otherwise in compliance with law. No <u>Green Deal User</u> shall process such data for its own marketing purposes or commercial promotion without the prior written consent of that other participant.
- 10.9. The <u>Code Manager</u> shall maintain and publish on a website specified by the Secretary of State a detailed and accurate list of <u>Data Controllers</u> who are expected to Process <u>Personal Data</u> in connection with the <u>Green Deal</u>.

#### **Liability Limits**

10.10. Paragraph 10.10 applies in addition to Clause 14 (limitation of Liability) of the main body of this Code.



10.11. The caps on liability set out in Clause 14.3 of the main body of this <u>Code</u> shall not apply in respect of liability arising under or in connection with this <u>REC Schedule</u>. Instead, the <u>Liability</u> of each <u>Green Deal User</u> and of <u>RECCo</u> under or in relation to this <u>REC Schedule</u> shall be limited to five million pounds (£5,000,000).

## **Third Party Rights**

- 10.12. Paragraph 10.12 supplements Clauses 26.11, 26.12 and 26.13 (Contract (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999) of the main body of this Code.
- 10.13. The following persons shall be entitled to enforce the following provisions of this REC Schedule:
  - (a) the Secretary of State shall be entitled to enforce the provisions of this REC Schedule that confer a right on the Secretary of State; and
  - (b) applicants shall be entitled to enforce their appeal rights under Paragraph 4.
- 11 Transfer of rights and obligations to **Green Deal Finance Parties**

## **Transfer by Green Deal Provider**

- 11.1. A <u>Green Deal Provider</u> may transfer certain rights and obligations under this <u>REC Schedule</u> to a <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u>, in respect of one or more <u>Green Deal Plans</u> (including the right to receive remittances of <u>Green Deal Charges</u>) by means of a duly executed <u>Notice of Transfer</u>.
- 11.2. Upon a Notice of Transfer under Paragraph 11.1 (and any changes to its Annex) becoming effective (in accordance with the form set out on the REC Portal):
  - (a) the relevant <u>Green Deal Provider</u> shall notify the relevant <u>Electricity Supplier</u>(s) and the Secretary of State within 2 <u>Working Day</u>s;
  - (b) the effect of that <u>Notice of Transfer</u> shall be to transfer, with respect to the <u>Nominated Green Deal Plans</u>:
    - (i) all of the Green Deal Provider's rights under this Schedule;
    - (ii) the obligations in Paragraphs 15.1, 15.2, 17.1, 20.7, 20.33, 21.5.1, 21.9



and 21.12.

- (c) the references to the term "Green Deal Provider" in the definition of Remittance Person, the definition of Green Deal Trust Property and in Paragraphs 14.4, 14.3.20, 15.2.1, 16.3.1, 20.1 to 20.8, 21.1, 21.3 and 21.15 shall be deemed to be replaced by a reference to that Green Deal Finance Party, with respect to the Nominated Green Deal Plan(s); and
- (d) the relevant <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u> undertakes to the relevant <u>Electricity</u> <u>Supplier(s)</u> to honour the obligations transferred to that <u>Green Deal Finance</u> Party under the Notice of Transfer.

#### Transfer by Green Deal Finance Party

- 11.3. A <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u> may novate its rights and obligations under this <u>REC Schedule</u> in respect of one or more <u>Nominated Green Deal Plans</u> to another <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u>, by means of a duly executed <u>Notice of Transfer</u>.
- 11.4. Upon a Notice of Transfer under Paragraph 11.3 (and any changes to its Annex) becoming effective (in accordance with the form set out on the REC Portal):
  - (a) the transferor <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u> shall notify the relevant <u>Electricity</u> Supplier(s) and the Secretary of State within 2 Working Days; and
  - (b) the transferee <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u> shall have all rights and obligations set out in the <u>Notice of Transfer</u>, in respect of the relevant <u>Nominated Green Deal Plans</u>.

#### Part C – Operational Processes

#### 12 Message Exchange and Validation

#### 12.1. Each GDCC User shall ensure that:

- (a) any data that it sends to the GDCC or enters onto the database is correct; and
- (b) any communication to the <u>GDCC</u> via a <u>Market Message</u> shall contain the required information, as set out in the <u>Data Specification</u>, to allow the processing of that <u>Market Message</u>.



- 12.2. A GDCC User may not send a notification to the GDCC that would have the effect of requiring a manual retrospective change to Green Deal Arrangements Data in relation to a period prior to the organisation becoming a GDCC User.
- 12.3. Validation by the GDCC shall include:
  - (a) initial data validation;
  - (b) MPAN Core validation;
  - (c) Green Deal Charge Data validation; and
  - (d) Standard message validation.
- 12.4. Initial data validation shall include confirmation that:
  - (a) all mandatory fields are present;
  - (b) the Party Instruction Number provided is unique for the sending party;
  - (c) the <u>EPC Property Reference Number provided</u> is in the required format for the relevant <u>EPC Register</u>;
  - (d) the <u>EPC Report Reference</u> provided is in the required format for the relevant <u>EPC</u> Register;
  - (e) the MPAN Core(s) provided are for a valid MPAS identifier;
  - (f) the postcode provided is in a valid format;
  - (g) the Green Deal Provider Plan Creator value is in the valid set;
  - (h) the Green Deal Provider Registration Reference is recognised by the GDCC;
  - (i) where the <u>Green Deal Provider Plan Creator</u> value is set to 'P', the <u>Green Deal Provider Registration Reference</u> is associated to the <u>Green Deal Provider MPID</u> for the sender of the request; or set to 'A', the <u>Green Deal Provider Registration Reference</u> is associated to the <u>Green Deal Provider MPID</u> of the <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u> who is the sender of the request; and
  - (j) the <u>Green Deal Provider MPID</u> is both valid and associated with the appropriate role for the effective date of the proposed new <u>Green Deal Plan ID</u>.



- 12.5. MPAN Core validation requires the GDCC to compare the MPAN Core provided via the relevant Market Message with data held by the Electricity Enquiry Service to ensure the following conditions are met:
  - (a) the MPAN Core is not associated to an export supply;
  - (b) the MPAN Core has a 'Traded' status;
  - (c) the <u>MPAN Core</u> Is registered to an <u>Electricity Supplier</u> who is a <u>Green Deal</u> Licensee; and
  - (d) the MPAN Core Is not 'in flight' between Electricity Suppliers; and
  - (e) the <u>MPAN Core</u> does not have a future registration to an <u>Electricity Supplier</u> who is not a <u>Green Deal Licensee</u>.
- 12.6. Green Deal charge data validation shall include confirmation that:
  - (a) the submitted first <u>Green Deal Charge Start Date</u> is not less than 20 <u>Working Days</u> or more than 60 <u>Working Days</u> from the date of entry of the <u>Green Deal Arrangements Data</u> onto the <u>GDCC</u>;
  - (b) the <u>Green Deal Arrangements Data</u> includes a contiguous series of <u>Green Deal Charge Periods</u>, each with a relevant <u>Green Deal Charge Start Date</u> and a relevant <u>Green Deal Charge End Date</u>, and the last <u>Green Deal Charge End Date</u> and the Green Deal Plan End Date shall be the same as the end date for the relevant <u>Green Deal Plan</u>; and
  - (c) the aggregate of the <u>Green Deal Electricity Savings</u>, the <u>Green Deal Gas Savings</u> and the <u>Green Deal Other Fuel Savings</u> minus the aggregate Daily <u>Green Deal Charges</u> for the 12 month period commencing on the first <u>Green Deal Charge Start Date</u> results in a zero or positive value (a pass). Where the calculation results in a negative value the data shall fail validation.
- 12.7. Standard message validation shall include confirmation that:
  - (a) the Party Instruction Number provided is unique for the sending party:
  - (b) only the required fields are populated;
  - (c) the Green Deal Plan ID provided is present in the database;



- (d) the status of the Green Deal Plan is appropriate for the specific message;
- (e) the <u>Green Deal Plan</u> record is in a state where an update can be processed e.g. previous messages have been received or another change is not already being processed;
- (f) that the sending party is the <u>Green Deal Provider</u> or <u>Electricity Supplier</u> associated to the Green Deal Plan ID in the GDCC; and
- (g) the <u>Green Deal Provider MPID</u> is both valid and associated with the appropriate role for the effective date of the proposed <u>Green Deal Plan</u> record status update.
- 12.8. Verification by the **Electricity Supplier** shall include confirmation that:
  - (a) the <u>Green Deal MPAN Core</u> corresponds with the relevant Electricity account number;
  - (b) the <u>Electricity Supplier</u> is registered against the <u>Green Deal MPAN Core</u> and, at the time of the verification, it considers that such registration is not an Erroneous Registration; and
  - (c) the <u>Consumer</u> for the relevant Electricity account number is reasonably identifiable by name.
- 12.9. If at anytime, the <u>GDCC</u> validation identifies an issue that cannot be resolved (e.g. the incoming <u>Market Message</u> cannot be associated to a valid <u>GDCC Instruction Number</u>), then the <u>GDCC</u> shall generate a report for <u>Code Manager</u> investigation. The <u>Code Manager</u> shall inform the sender of the <u>Market Message</u> within 2 <u>Working Day</u>s of the <u>Market Message</u> being received by the <u>GDCC</u>, who shall resolve the issue in accordance with Paragraph 12.10.
- 12.10. Where a <u>Market Message</u> is rejected as a result of any validation (including supplier verification) defined in this Paragraph 12, the <u>Green Deal Provider</u> or <u>Electricity Supplier</u> shall have the option:
  - (a) to send a notification to the <u>GDCC</u> containing revised data that it wishes to resubmit:
  - (b) where the relevant <u>Green Deal Plan</u> has already been entered into, to send a notification to the <u>GDCC</u> to reflect the <u>Green Deal Plan</u> having come to an end; or



- (c) where a proposed <u>Green Deal Plan</u> has not been entered into, to send a notification to the <u>GDCC</u> to reflect the ending of the setup and validation process.
- 12.11. The <u>GDCC</u> shall record the status of each <u>Green Deal Plan</u> record and have logical rules regarding status transition. These statuses are as follows:
  - (a) **New** where a unique <u>Green Deal Plan ID</u> has been created and initial checks undertaken in the <u>GDCC</u>, but no request for a notification to be sent to the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> has been generated to the relevant <u>Green Deal Licensee</u>;
  - (b) Pending where a request has been generated to the <u>Green Deal Licensee</u> to issue an initial notification of a pending <u>Green Deal Plan</u> to the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u>, and the <u>Green Deal Licensee</u> has confirmed that supplier verification has been successful in relation to that request;
  - (c) Live Green Deal Charge information has been sent to the <u>Green Deal Licensee</u> and the <u>Green Deal Licensee</u> has confirmed that the supplier verification has been successful in relation to that request;
  - (d) **Complete** the <u>Green Deal Plan Actual End Date</u> associated with a <u>Green Deal</u> Plan record in the GDCC has been reached; and
  - (e) **Cancelled** The <u>Green Deal Provider</u> has successfully notified the <u>GDCC</u> that a <u>Green Deal Plan</u> was cancelled at a date prior to any "GD MPAN EFD" or "GD MPAN ETD" being applied to the associated <u>Green Deal MPAN Core</u> in MPAS.
- 12.12. The statuses defined in Paragraph 12.11 shall be utilised throughout the <u>Green Deal</u> process contained in this Schedule, with allowable activities defined by the current status of the relevant <u>Green Deal Plan</u>. The allowed transitions between statuses are set out below:

## Establishing a new **Green Deal Plan**

13.1. Where a <u>Green Deal Provider</u> agrees a quotation for a proposed <u>Green Deal Plan</u>, it shall ensure the relevant details are included within the <u>GDCC</u>, in accordance with the interface table below.

#### 17 Change of Green Deal Bill Payer

17.1. Where the relevant <u>Green Deal Provider</u> becomes aware that there is a change in <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> it shall tell that new <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> to contact the relevant <u>Electricity Supplier</u>. The <u>Electricity Supplier</u> is responsible for updating the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> details within the <u>GDCC</u> as set out below.

#### Maintenance of **Default Bill Payer** Information

17.2. Where the <u>Electricity Supplier</u> is the <u>Registered Supplier</u> for a <u>Metering Point</u> but does not have an associated <u>Consumer</u> record, the <u>Green Deal Provider</u> (or <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u> for a <u>Nominated Green Deal Plan</u>) is responsible for maintaining data related to the <u>Default Bill Payer</u>. Where the relevant <u>Green Deal Provider</u> becomes aware that there is a change to the <u>Default Bill Payer</u>, it shall follow the process set out below:

<u>Green Deal Plan(s)</u> only (and without prejudice to the terms of its <u>Access Agreement</u>), be treated as equivalent in all material respects to a user of the <u>GDCC</u> that is a <u>Green Deal Provider</u>.

#### 19 Retrospective Amendments to Green Deal Central Charging Database

- 19.1. Where a GDCC User identifies a need to correct data submitted to the GDCC and such an amendment cannot be made via the standard process in accordance with Paragraph 15, they shall contact the Code Manager and provide details of:
  - (a) the erroneous data submitted; and
  - (b) the revisions required.
- 19.2. On such notification, the <u>Code Manager</u> shall assess the request to determine the required actions to effect a correction of the data.
- 19.3. Where, in the opinion of the <u>Code Manager</u>, the data can be corrected via the use of a <u>DTN Market Message</u>, the <u>Code Manager</u> shall contact the GDCC User who identified the need to correct the data and (where a different person) any GDCC User who would need to generate the <u>DTN Market Message</u> in order to correct the erroneous data and provide sufficient information to allow the correction to be made.
- 19.4. Where, in the sole opinion of the <u>Code Manager</u>, manual retrospective amendments to data in the <u>GDCC</u> will be required, the <u>Code Manager</u> shall:
  - (a) confirm the need for a manual retrospective amendment to the notifying <u>GDCC</u> User and (if a different person), the <u>GDCC</u> User that entered the erroneous data into the <u>GDCC</u>;
  - (b) liaise with the <u>GDCC Provider</u> to confirm the timings and nature of manual amendments to be made to the <u>GDCC</u>;
  - (c) liaise with all affected GDCC Users to ensure that, when applied, any retrospective amendments result in alignment of data between affected organisations systems;
  - (d) ensure that the required manual retrospective amendments are carried out;



- (e) calculate the costs of correcting the erroneous data and inform <u>RECCo</u> of these; and
- (f) on approval from <u>RECCo</u>, ensure that an appropriate amount is invoiced to the GDCC User that entered the erroneous data into the GDCC.

#### PART D - Green Deal Charges and Quarterly Payments

#### **20 Green Deal Charges**

#### **Rights and Obligations**

- 20.1. Section 1(6) of the Energy Act 2011 makes provision for the payment and collection of <u>Green Deal Charges</u> and provides, among other things, that <u>Green Deal Charges</u> are to be:
  - (a) recoverable as debts by the relevant <u>Electricity Supplier</u> from the relevant <u>Green</u> Deal Bill Payer; and
  - (b) recovered and held by the relevant <u>Electricity Supplier</u> as agent and trustee for the relevant <u>Green Deal Provider</u> (unless the relevant <u>Electricity Supplier</u> is also that person).
- 20.2. This Paragraph 20 and Paragraph 21 set out the terms on which each <u>Electricity</u> <u>Supplier</u> shall recover and hold <u>Green Deal Charges</u>, and also provide for the remittance of such payments to <u>Green Deal Provider</u>s (or their nominees).
- 20.3. The relevant <u>Green Deal Provider</u> and the relevant <u>Electricity Supplier</u> acknowledge and agree that the <u>Electricity Supplier</u> shall act as the <u>Green Deal Provider</u>'s agent and trustee for the collection of <u>Green Deal Charges</u> for any relevant <u>Green Deal Plan</u>, following the <u>Green Deal Charge Start Date</u>, on the terms of this Paragraph 20.
- 20.4. Paragraph 20.3 shall not apply where the <u>Green Deal Provider</u> is the same person as the relevant <u>Electricity Supplier</u>.
- 20.5. Any action that an <u>Electricity Supplier</u> takes, or purports to take, on behalf of a <u>Green Deal Provider</u> at a time when the <u>Electricity Supplier</u> is not authorised to do so, shall, if subsequently ratified by the <u>Green Deal Provider</u>, be as valid as if the <u>Green Deal Provider</u> had expressly authorised that action in advance.



- 20.6. Each Supplier shall, while acting as agent and trustee for a <u>Green Deal Provider</u>, act towards the relevant <u>Green Deal Provider</u> conscientiously and in good faith.
- 20.7. Subject to Paragraphs 20.23 and 20.31, while an <u>Electricity Supplier</u> is acting as agent and trustee for a <u>Green Deal Provider</u>, the relevant <u>Green Deal Provider</u> shall:
  - (a) act conscientiously and in good faith at all times toward that **Electricity Supplier**;
  - (b) not collect or attempt to collect <u>Green Deal Charges</u> directly from the relevant Green Deal Bill Payer; and
  - (c) not appoint anyone else as agent for the collection of <u>Green Deal Charges</u> under the relevant <u>Green Deal Plan</u>.
- 20.8. Each <u>Electricity Supplier</u> shall hold each item of <u>Green Deal Trust Property</u> on trust for the benefit of the relevant <u>Green Deal Provider</u>. This means that <u>Electricity Suppliers</u> shall have:
  - (a) no beneficial interest in any Green Deal Trust Property; and
  - (b) no right to use <u>Green Deal Charges</u> for their own business purposes in the period between recovering them from <u>Green Deal Bill Payers</u> and remitting them to <u>Green Deal Providers</u>.
- 20.9. Each <u>Green Deal Provider</u> acknowledges that, when <u>Green Deal Charges</u> are recovered and held by an <u>Electricity Supplier</u>, they may be commingled with the <u>Electricity Supplier</u>'s own funds.
- 20.10. Each <u>Electricity Supplier</u> has the power to invest <u>Green Deal Charges</u> recovered and held by it by placing them on deposit with a bank and:
  - (a) the deposits may be made in the name of the <u>Electricity Supplier</u> or in the name of an <u>Affiliate</u> of the <u>Electricity Supplier</u>; and
  - (b) the funds so deposited may remain commingled with the <u>Electricity Supplier</u>'s own funds and those of its <u>Affiliate(s)</u>,
- 20.11. provided that the Electricity Supplier must notify the relevant bank and account



holding <u>Affiliate</u> (where applicable) that the <u>Green Deal Charges</u> in the bank account are held on trust for the benefit of <u>Green Deal Provider</u>s pursuant to section 1(6) of the Energy Act 2011 and this <u>REC Schedule</u>.

- 20.12. Any interest or other benefits (if any) earned by an <u>Electricity Supplier</u> with respect to <u>Green Deal Charges</u> held by it shall belong to the relevant <u>Electricity Supplier</u>.
- 20.13. Each <u>Electricity Supplier</u> must keep a balance in the bank account into which <u>Green Deal Charges</u> are received or invested under Paragraph 20.10 at least equal to the value of <u>Green Deal Charges</u> that it reasonably estimates that it is holding at any given time.
- 20.14. If an <u>Electricity Supplier</u> holds insufficient funds to remit <u>Green Deal Charges</u> already received by it to the relevant <u>Green Deal Providers</u>, the trust claims of the relevant <u>Green Deal Providers</u> in respect of those <u>Green Deal Charges</u> shall abate rateably with each other.

### **Recovery of Green Deal Charges**

- 20.15. The amount of <u>Green Deal Charges</u> to recover shall be determined by reference to the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u>'s payment method for electricity bills and the requirements in Appendix 2. For each <u>Green Deal Plan</u>, the <u>Green Deal Charges</u> are set out in the notifications described in Paragraph 14, and changes to the data may be made according to the processes in Paragraph 15.
- 20.16. An <u>Electricity Supplier</u> shall not cancel or amend, or in any dealing with a <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> purport to cancel or amend (either in part or whole), an obligation to pay a Green Deal Charge.
- 20.17. Each <u>Electricity Supplier</u> shall use comparable processes and efforts to recover <u>Green Deal Charges</u> from the relevant <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> that it uses to collect Charges for the Supply of Electricity.
- 20.18. This <u>REC Schedule</u> shall not require a <u>Gaining Supplier</u> to recover a <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u>'s <u>Green Deal Charges</u> that fell due for recovery by a <u>Losing Supplier</u> prior to the time that the <u>Gaining Supplier</u> became the <u>Green Deal Provider</u>'s agent and trustee for the collection of <u>Green Deal Charges</u> for that <u>Green Deal Plan</u>, unless that <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> owes <u>Outstanding Charges</u> that are <u>Charges for the Supply of Electricity</u> that



fell due for recovery by the <u>Losing Supplier</u> and the <u>Gaining Supplier</u> agrees to recover those <u>Outstanding Charges</u>.

- 20.19. Where a <u>Green Deal Premises</u> becomes vacant or is de-energised, Daily <u>Green Deal Charges</u> shall still accrue and the obligation to recover <u>Green Deal Charges</u> from the relevant <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> does not end.
- 20.20. <u>Green Deal Providers</u> acknowledge that under Condition 36.11 (Payment method and frequency of billing) of the <u>Electricity Supply Licences</u>, where a <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> who is not an Electricity Consumer requests receipt of a bill before paying <u>Green Deal Charges</u>, an <u>Electricity Supplier</u> must send that <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> a bill in relation to those <u>Green Deal Charges</u> at intervals of not more than 3 months.
- 20.21. When dealing with <u>Green Deal Bill Payers</u>, each <u>Electricity Supplier</u> shall have regard to any guidance on debt collection issued by the Financial Conduct Authority prevailing from time to time.

#### **Cessation of Green Deal Charges**

20.22. Where:

- (a) the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> owes <u>Outstanding Charges</u> for both <u>Charges for the Supply of Electricity</u> and <u>Green Deal Charges</u>, and:
  - (i) the relevant <u>Electricity Supplier</u> collects from the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> an amount less than the <u>Outstanding Charges</u>, in full and final settlement of those <u>Outstanding Charges</u>;
  - (ii) a third party debt collector appointed by the <u>Electricity Supplier</u> as its agent for collection collects from the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> an amount less than the <u>Outstanding Charges</u>, in full and final settlement of those <u>Outstanding Charges</u>; or

in each case, such amount being the "Collected Amount";

(iii) a third party debt collector pays the <u>Electricity Supplier</u> an amount less than the <u>Outstanding Charges</u> in consideration of transferring the right to collect those <u>Outstanding Charges</u> directly from the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u>,



(b) such Collected Amount<sup>108</sup> is applied in proportion and equally without any preference between them to the <u>Outstanding Charges</u> for <u>Charges for the Supply of Electricity</u> and the <u>Green Deal Charges</u>;

<sup>108</sup> Which shall be deemed to be net of any fee charged to the <u>Electricity</u> <u>Supplier</u> by the third party debt collector for its collection service (in relation to the relevant <u>Green Deal Bill Payer only</u>).

- (c) the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> has ceased to be liable to pay the relevant <u>Electricity</u> <u>Supplier</u>'s electricity bills for the property accruing from time to time; and
- (d) the <u>Electricity Supplier</u> sends a notification to the <u>GDCC</u> confirming at least the following:
  - (i) a negotiated settlement has occurred;
  - (ii) the amount of the <u>Green Deal Charges</u> that, as a result, have not been collected; and
  - (iii) the last known address of the Green Deal Bill Payer,
  - then the <u>Green Deal Provider</u> authorises and accepts such reduction in Green Deal Charge arrears as a binding reduction to the total <u>Green Deal Charges</u> payable under the relevant <u>Green Deal Plan</u>.

#### 20.23. Where:

- (a) the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> owes <u>Outstanding Charges</u> that are:
  - (i) Charges for the Supply of Electricity and Green Deal Charges; or
  - (ii) Green Deal Charges;
- (b) the relevant <u>Electricity Supplier</u> decides not to collect the whole of those <u>Outstanding Charges</u> from the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u>;
- (c) the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> has ceased to be liable to pay the relevant <u>Electricity</u> Supplier's electricity bills for the property accruing from time to time; and
- (d) the <u>Electricity Supplier</u> sends a notification to the <u>GDCC</u> confirming at least the following:
  - (i) a cancellation of the <u>Outstanding Charges</u> that are <u>Charges for the Supply</u> of Electricity has occurred;



- (ii) the amount of the <u>Green Deal Charges</u> that, as a result, have not been collected; and
- (iii) the last known address of the Green Deal Bill Payer,

then that <u>Electricity Supplier</u> shall no longer be under an obligation to collect and remit the Green Deal Charge arrears.

20.24. Where a notification under Paragraph 20.21(d) or 20.22(d) is received by the GDCC, the relevant Remittance Processor shall be notified following the process below:

# **Bill Payer Insolvency**

20.25. Where:

(a) a Green Deal Bill Payer is subject to an Insolvency Event;

#### (b) that **Green Deal Bill Payer**:

- (i) owes <u>Outstanding Charges</u> that are <u>Charges for the Supply of</u> <u>Electricity</u> and <u>Green Deal Charges</u>; or <u>Green Deal Charges</u>; and
- (ii) has ceased to be liable to pay the relevant <u>Electricity Supplier</u>'s electricity bills for the property accruing from time to time (whether as a result of the relevant <u>Electricity Supplier</u> deciding not to collect the whole of those <u>Outstanding Charges</u> from the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> or otherwise); and
- (c) the <u>Electricity Supplier</u> sends a notification to the <u>GDCC</u> confirming at least the following:
  - (i) the identity of the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> that is subject to an <u>Insolvency</u> <u>Event</u> and the date on which that <u>Insolvency Event</u> occurred;
  - (ii) the amount of the <u>Green Deal Charges</u> that, as a result, have not been collected; and
  - (iii) the last known address of that Green Deal Bill Payer,
  - then that <u>Electricity Supplier</u> shall no longer be under an obligation to collect and remit the Green Deal Charge arrears and shall treat the relevant Green Deal Bill Payer's Account as closed as of the date of the <u>Insolvency Event</u>.

#### 20.26. Where Paragraph 20.24 applies:

- (a) that Green Deal Bill Payer's Account shall be closed with effect from the date of the <u>Insolvency Event</u>, and charges due up to that date shall be included on a final account; and
- (b) any payments made after the date the Green Deal Bill Payer's Account is closed shall be refunded directly to that <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u>.

#### Other considerations

20.27. Nothing in this Paragraph 20 shall prevent an <u>Electricity Supplier</u> from cancelling <u>Outstanding Charges</u> that are either <u>Charges</u> for the <u>Supply of Electricity</u> or any amount other than a <u>Green Deal Charges</u> owed by a <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u>.



- 20.28. Where an Electricity Consumer (who is a <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u>) undergoes a <u>Switch</u>, and the <u>Losing Supplier</u> collects Green Deal Charge arrears from that Electricity Consumer, the prevailing Remittance Bank Account specified on the <u>GDCC</u> for the relevant <u>Green Deal Plan</u> shall be used.
- 20.29. If, following an <u>Electricity Supplier</u> receiving a settlement in accordance with Paragraph 20.21, such <u>Electricity Supplier</u> receives additional payment from the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> for the relevant <u>Outstanding Charges</u> in excess of such settlement, such excess amount shall be treated as a Payment under Paragraph 2.2.1(b) of Appendix 2.
- 20.30. Where the <u>Authority</u> decides that an <u>Electricity Supplier</u> has breached Condition 37.9 (Notice of Green Deal Charge arrears) of its <u>Electricity Supply Licence</u> or where the <u>Electricity Supplier</u> accepts that it has not complied with that condition:
  - (a) the relevant <u>Green Deal Provider</u> shall, within 10 <u>Working Days</u> of being notified of such breach or non-compliance, directly reimburse the relevant <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> all interest (and fees, if any) charged and collected in respect of <u>Green Deal Charges</u> for such period(s) of breach or non-compliance; and
  - (b) the <u>Electricity Supplier</u> shall reimburse the relevant <u>Green Deal Provider</u> the amount under this Paragraph 20.29 within 20 <u>Working Days</u> of receipt of an invoice from the <u>Green Deal Provider</u>.
- 20.31. On receipt of a notification from the Secretary of State that the liability of a <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> to make <u>Green Deal Charges</u> is cancelled or reduced pursuant to Chapter 3 of Part 8 of the <u>Green Deal Framework Regulations</u>, the relevant:
  - (a) Green Deal Provider (in the case of a Green Deal Plan); or
  - (b) Green Deal Finance Party (in the case of a Nominated Green Deal Plan),
- 20.32. shall immediately update the GDCC to reflect such cancellation or reduction.
- 20.33. Where (pursuant to the Consumer Credit Act 1974 or otherwise) a <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> wishes (and is entitled) to discharge some or all liabilities under the <u>Green Deal Plan</u> by paying some or all remaining <u>Green Deal Charges</u>, whether or not presently due, and notifies the relevant:



- (a) <u>Electricity Supplier</u>, the <u>Electricity Supplier</u> shall inform the relevant <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> that the sum to be paid with respect to such <u>Green Deal Charges</u> should be paid directly to the relevant <u>Green Deal Provider</u>;
- (b) <u>Green Deal Provider</u>, the <u>Green Deal Provider</u> shall update the <u>GDCC</u> within 3 <u>Working Days</u> of receiving payment from the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u>; or
- (c) where the Green Deal Plan is a Nominated Green Deal Plan:
  - (i) <u>Green Deal Provider</u>, the <u>Green Deal Provider</u> shall notify the relevant <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u> within 3 <u>Working Day</u>s of receiving payment from the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> and that <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u> shall update the <u>GDCC</u> within 3 <u>Working Day</u>s of such notification; or
  - (ii) <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u>, the <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u> shall: (A) inform the relevant <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> that the sum to be paid with respect to such <u>Green Deal Charges</u> should be paid directly to the relevant <u>Green Deal Provider</u>; and (B) update the <u>GDCC</u>, within 3 <u>Working Days</u> of receiving a notification under Paragraph 20.31 (c)(i).
- 20.34. Where a <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> wishes (and is entitled) to discharge some or all liabilities under the <u>Green Deal Plan</u> under Paragraph 20.31, the <u>Green Deal Provider</u> shall ensure that they take reasonable endeavours to allow for the maximum time for the amendments to be made to the <u>Green Deal Charge Start Date</u>.

20.35. Where:

- (a) a Green Deal Plan is amended under Paragraph 20.30 or 20.31;
- (b) all remaining Green Deal Charges have been paid; and
- (c) the total funds that have been remitted under Paragraph 21 (whether by one or more <u>Electricity Supplier</u>) less any <u>Reclaimed Amounts</u> (whether by one or more <u>Electricity Supplier</u>) are, in aggregate, greater than the total <u>Green Deal</u> <u>Charges</u> payable under that <u>Green Deal Plan</u>,
- the relevant Remittance Person (or, where it is a Nominee Remittance Person, the Green Deal User which nominated it) shall within 10 Working Days of receiving such excess amount, reimburse the prevailing Green Deal Bill Payer that excess amount.

#### 21 Remittance of Green Deal Charges



- 21.1. A <u>Green Deal Provider</u> may (in respect of a <u>Green Deal Plan</u>) and a <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u> may (in respect of a <u>Nominated Green Deal Plan</u>):
  - (a) directly receive Remittance Amounts (and pay Reclaimed Amounts) under this REC Schedule; or
  - (b) nominate a person to receive <u>Remittance Amounts</u> (and to pay <u>Reclaimed Amounts</u>) in place of that <u>Green Deal Provider</u> (which person is known as a <u>Nominee Remittance Person</u>).
- 21.2. Each <u>Green Deal Provider</u> may specify one Remittance Bank Account in respect of each <u>Remittance Person</u> within the <u>GDCC</u>, and may update it from time to time.
- 21.3. Each <u>Green Deal Provider</u> that has nominated one or more <u>Nominee Remittance Persons</u>, represents that it has the right of access to any <u>Remittance Information</u> provided to such <u>Nominee Remittance Persons</u> under this Paragraph 21.
- 21.4. The Remittance Person that holds the Remittance Bank Account shall (or, where it is a Nominee Remittance Person, the Green Deal User which nominated it shall procure that the Nominee Remittance Person shall) provide the relevant Electricity Supplier with such information as it reasonably requires to verify the Remittance Person's identity prior to instructing the funds transfer.
- 21.5. The Electricity Supplier shall remit funds in accordance with the following process:

- 21.6. Where more than one <u>Remittance Amount</u> is to be transferred to a Remittance Processor on a particular day, those <u>Remittance Amounts</u> may be remitted in aggregate to that <u>Remittance Person</u>, but separate notices must be sent in respect of each <u>Green Deal Plan</u>.
- 21.7. Where the <u>GDCC</u> is unavailable (on either a scheduled or unscheduled basis) notifications under this Paragraph 21 shall be given as soon as reasonably practicable after the <u>GDCC</u> becomes available.

## Amount of **Green Deal Charges** to remit

21.8. The amount of Green Deal Charges to remit to Green Deal Providers shall be

## Reclaim of remitted **Green Deal Charges**

- 21.9. Subject to Paragraph 21.10, where, for a <u>Green Deal Plan</u>, an <u>Electricity Supplier</u> has remitted funds under Paragraph 21.5:
  - (a) in excess of the Remittance Amount payable on a Remittance Date;
  - (b) which is an amount remitted under Paragraph 1.4.1(a) of Appendix 2 and the <u>Electricity Supplier</u> is unable to recover it from the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> under the Additional Conditions in Paragraph 1.4.1(c) of Appendix 12; or
  - (c) which had been collected from the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> and such amounts (in whole or in part) have subsequently been refunded to the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u>,
  - then the <u>Electricity Supplier</u> may reclaim from the prevailing <u>Remittance Person</u> (or, where it is a <u>Nominee Remittance Person</u>, the <u>Green Deal User</u> which nominated it) an amount equivalent to that excess, unrecoverable amount or refund (as applicable) (known as a <u>Reclaimed Amount</u>), and the relevant <u>Green Deal Provider</u> shall indemnify the <u>Electricity Supplier</u> in respect of any amounts a <u>Nominee Remittance Person</u> owes that <u>Electricity Supplier</u>.
- 21.10. Paragraph 21.9 shall not apply to any amounts where a period of more than 27 months has lapsed since that amount was remitted under Paragraph 21.5.
- 21.11. The <u>Electricity Supplier</u> shall, as soon as reasonably practicable, send a notification to the <u>GDCC</u> of the <u>Remittance Information</u> for each <u>Green Deal Plan</u> to which the <u>Reclaimed Amount</u> relates. This shall be done in accordance with the process in Paragraph 21.5.
- 21.12. Where the notification under Paragraph 21.11:
  - (a) is given on a Remittance Date, the Remittance Amount and the Reclaimed Amount shall be aggregated to produce a single net amount, and where this is a negative amount, the Remittance Person shall (or, where it is a Nominee Remittance Person, the Green Deal User which nominated it shall procure that the Nominee Remittance Person shall) as soon as reasonably practicable, but in any event not more than 3 Working Days, instruct the funds transfer of the



- absolute value of that amount to the prevailing Supplier Bank Account of the relevant Electricity Supplier; or
- (b) is not given on a <u>Remittance Date</u>, the <u>Remittance Person</u> shall (or, where it is a <u>Nominee Remittance Person</u>, the <u>Green Deal User</u> which nominated it shall procure that the <u>Nominee Remittance Person</u> shall) as soon as reasonably practicable, but in any event not more than 3 <u>Working Days</u>, instruct the funds transfer of the <u>Reclaimed Amount</u> to the prevailing Supplier Bank Account of the relevant <u>Electricity Supplier</u>.
- 21.13. The relevant <u>Electricity Supplier</u> that holds the Supplier Bank Account shall provide the relevant <u>Remittance Person</u> with such information as it reasonably requires to verify the <u>Electricity Supplier</u>'s identity prior to instructing the funds transfer.
- 21.14. Where more than one <u>Reclaimed Amount</u> is to be reclaimed on a particular day, they may be reclaimed in aggregate from the relevant <u>Green Deal User</u>, but separate notices must be sent in respect of each <u>Green Deal Plan</u>.
- 21.15. Where a <u>Green Deal Provider</u> has nominated a <u>Nominee Remittance Person</u>, such nomination shall not take effect until the <u>Green Deal Provider</u> specifies a Remittance Bank Account on the <u>GDCC</u> in the name of the <u>Nominee Remittance Person</u>.
- 21.16. Where, for a Green Deal Plan:
  - (a) the payment frequency for the relevant <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> is monthly (which shall be determined solely by reference to item "GD Energy Payment Frequency" in the relevant Provide Remittance Details Market Message); and
  - (b) 74 calendar days has lapsed since the relevant <u>Green Deal Remittance</u> <u>Processor</u> was last notified of the <u>Remittance Information</u> for that <u>Green Deal Plan under Paragraph 21.5</u>,
  - then the <u>Electricity Supplier</u> shall, within 3 <u>Working Day</u>s, send a notification to the <u>GDCC</u> (using the Provide Remittance Details Market Message) of the <u>Remittance Information</u> for that <u>Green Deal Plan</u>, with the <u>Remittance Amount</u> set (for the purpose of this Paragraph only) to zero.
- 21.17. Where, for a Green Deal Plan:



- (a) the payment frequency for that <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> is quarterly (which shall be determined solely by reference to item "GD Energy Payment frequency" in the relevant Provide Remittance Details Market Message); and
- (b) 145 calendar days has lapsed since the relevant <u>Green Deal Remittance Processor</u> was last notified of the <u>Remittance Information</u> for that <u>Green Deal Plan</u> under Paragraph 21.5,
- then the <u>Electricity Supplier</u> shall, within 3 <u>Working Day</u>s, send a notification to the <u>GDCC</u> (using the Provide Remittance Details Market Message) of the <u>Remittance Information</u> for that <u>Green Deal Plan</u>, with the <u>Remittance Amount</u> set (for the purpose of this Paragraph only) to zero.

## 22 Recovery and Distribution of **Green Deal Provider Quarterly Payments**

- 22.1. <u>Green Deal Providers</u> (or, in respect of <u>Nominated Green Deal Plans</u>, the relevant <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u>) are required under this <u>REC Schedule</u> to make payments to <u>RECCo</u> in respect of functions discharged in connection with <u>Green Deal</u> payments. <u>Quarterly Payments</u> by <u>Green Deal Providers</u> are based on an agreed daily amount (known as the <u>Base Amount</u>) paid for each day that each of them are associated with an applicable <u>Green Deal Plan</u>.
- 22.2. This <u>Base Amount</u> is payable from the date that the relevant charging information has been entered into the <u>GDCC</u>, until the <u>Green Deal Plan Actual End Date</u> (as stored in the <u>GDCC</u> against the related <u>Green Deal Plan</u> record) is reached.
- 22.3. The <u>Code Manager</u> shall nominate, from time to time, a bank account as the "<u>Quarterly Payment Bank Account</u>" for the purposes of this Paragraph 22. A funds transfer to the <u>Quarterly Payment Bank Account</u> shall be in full and final settlement of any liabilities owed under this REC Schedule to pay the relevant Quarterly Payments.
- 22.4. The <u>Quarterly Payment</u> payable by each <u>Green Deal Provider</u> and <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u> shall be an amount equal to the <u>Green Deal Plan Base Amount</u> multiplied by the Total Quarterly Plans, summed over each day in the Quarter.
- 22.5. <u>RECCo</u> shall use the <u>Quarterly Payments</u> received under this Paragraph 22 to offset the costs it would otherwise recover under Clause 9 (Annual Budget and Cost Recovery) of the main body of this Code.

Adjustments to Green Deal Plan Base Amount and Green Deal Plan Voluntary



#### **Supplier Amount**

- 22.6. The Secretary of State may from time to time review and specify (in pence per <u>Green Deal Plan</u>) a new <u>Green Deal Plan</u> <u>Base Amount</u>, provided that:
  - (a) it publishes its reasons for specifying the new amount;
  - (b) the previous <u>Green Deal Plan</u> <u>Base Amount</u> shall continue to apply to existing <u>Green Deal Plans</u> for the duration of their terms; and
  - (c) such new amount shall only apply to those <u>Green Deal Plan</u>s where the date the initial <u>Green Deal Arrangements Data</u> for such <u>Green Deal Plan</u> had been entered onto the <u>GDCC</u> after the date the new amount was specified.

## Quarterly payment threshold

- 22.7. The <u>REC Board</u> may from time to time determine the Quarterly Payment Threshold. This is a threshold amount below which the <u>Code Manager</u> shall not issue a request for payment in relation to a <u>Green Deal Provider</u>'s <u>Quarterly Payment</u>.
- 22.8. The <u>Code Manager</u> shall, within 10 <u>Working Day</u>s of the value for the Quarterly Payment Threshold having been determined, inform all <u>Green Deal Users</u> of that value by email.
- 22.9. Where a <u>Green Deal Providers Quarterly Payment</u> falls below the Quarterly Payment Threshold, the <u>Code Manager</u> shall accrue the amounts due until either:
  - (a) the sum of all that <u>Green Deal Provider</u>'s <u>Quarterly Payments</u> due exceeds the Quarterly Payment Threshold; or
  - (b) that <u>Green Deal Provider</u>'s <u>Quarterly Payments</u> for the final <u>Quarter</u> of the year are calculated.

#### **Process for Quarterly Payments by Green Deal Providers**

22.10. The <u>Green Deal Users</u> shall follow the process below in respect of <u>Quarterly</u> <u>Payments</u>:

#### Recovery of overdue payments

- 22.11. The <u>Code Manager</u> shall instigate the processes under Paragraph 22.12 if a <u>Green Deal Provider</u> or <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u> has not either:
  - (a) deposited a duly requested amount in the <u>Quarterly Payment Bank Account</u> by the due date; or
  - (b) raised a dispute regarding a request for payment or invoice received from <u>RECCo</u> and paid any parts of the monies due that are not in dispute.
- 22.12. The processes for the recovery of such overdue amounts are:
  - (a) where an amount is overdue by 15 <u>Working Days</u>, the <u>Code Manager</u> will contact the relevant person to request payment; such request may be verbal, by electronic means or via post as appropriate;
  - (b) where an amount is overdue by 30 Working Days, the Code Manager shall make a formal request for payment of the overdue amounts, which may include any accrued interest; and
  - (c) where an amount is overdue by 60 <u>Working Days</u>, the <u>Code Manager</u> shall report the matter to the <u>REC Performance Assurance Board</u>.

#### **Disputed Quarterly Payments**

- 22.13. A <u>Green Deal Provider</u> may dispute in good faith any sum requested under this Paragraph 22. Where a dispute is raised, the <u>Green Deal Provider</u> shall make payment of any undisputed amount in accordance with this Paragraph 22, and shall give notice in writing of the amount in dispute and the reasons for the dispute to the <u>Code Manager</u>.
- 22.14. No <u>Green Deal User</u> shall raise a dispute where a period of more than 12 months has lapsed since the sum was invoiced, remitted or transferred to it (as applicable).
- 22.15. Without prejudice to the provisions of Clause 22 (Disputes) in the main body of this



<u>Code</u>, the relevant <u>Green Deal User</u>s shall seek to settle the dispute as soon as reasonably possible.

22.16. Any adjustment payment required to be made in accordance with the resolution of a dispute under this Paragraph 22 shall be made within 3 Working Days of that resolution.

#### Interest

- 22.17. If a <u>Green Deal User</u> fails to pay any amount in accordance with this Paragraph 22, interest shall be payable on that amount at the <u>Relevant Interest Rate</u> compounded daily from the date that payment fell due, but excluding, the date payment is made.
- 22.18. If, following the resolution of a dispute or otherwise to correct any mistaken overpayment or underpayment made in good faith, a party is required to pay an amount under this Paragraph 22, interest shall be payable on that amount at an annual rate equal to the Relevant Interest Rate compounded daily from the date when the amount would have been paid or not paid (as applicable) if the dispute, overpayment or underpayment had not occurred until, but excluding, the date payment is made.

#### **Data Retention and Audit**

- 22.19. Each <u>Green Deal User</u> (where relevant) shall ensure, in respect of each <u>Green Deal Plan</u>, that it securely maintains a copy of the following data:
  - (a) in the case of an <u>Electricity Supplier</u>, <u>Green Deal Charges</u> recovered, held and remitted by it;
  - (b) in the case of a <u>Green Deal Provider</u> and a <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u>, <u>Green Deal Charges</u> remitted to it; and
  - (c) remittance Information sent and received by it under this Schedule and that such data is fully auditable, so that a full copy of data is maintained for a period of no less than 7 years following the date the Green Deal Charge was remitted by or to it (as applicable).
- 22.20. Each <u>Green Deal User</u> (where relevant) shall ensure that each of the Secretary of State and the <u>Authority</u> has access at reasonable times and on reasonable notice to



such data maintained by it under Paragraph 22.19.

22.21. Prior to the first <u>Green Deal Charge Start Date</u> for a <u>Green Deal Plan</u>, an <u>Electricity Supplier</u> must not (and is under no obligation to) collect any <u>Green Deal Charges</u> under the relevant <u>Green Deal Plan</u> and is under no obligation to remit any <u>Green Deal Charges</u> to the relevant <u>Green Deal Provider</u>, in respect of the relevant <u>Green Deal Plan</u>.

#### **Part E Performance Assurance**

#### 23 Performance Measurement

#### Reporting

- 23.1. The <u>Code Manager</u> shall, within 8 <u>Working Days</u> following the end of each month, circulate a report to each <u>Green Deal User</u>'s <u>Contract Manager</u>, reporting on the <u>Green Deal User</u>'s performance against the deadlines for provision of <u>Market Messages</u> in Part C of this <u>REC Schedule</u>. Each such report shall also be sent to the Secretary of State and the <u>REC Performance Assurance Board</u>.
- 23.2. The reporting provided under Paragraph 23.1 shall allow for:
  - (a) identification of instances of non-compliance relating to both:
    - I. provision of information or responses outside the required timescales; and
    - II. where the required information or response has not been received by the GDCC;
  - (b) presentation of trends over time; and
  - (c) numbers of each <u>Green Deal User</u>'s events of non-compliance against each relevant clause at a summary level in both absolute and percentage terms.
- 23.3. Where a <u>Green Deal User</u> is identified as being non-complaint, the <u>Contract Manager</u> of both the non-compliant party and the intended recipient of any related information shall be provided with reports by the <u>Code Manager</u> that allow for the identification of the affected <u>Green Deal Plan(s)</u>, and resolution of the non-compliance.



#### Performance Levels for **Green Deal Plans**

- 23.4. Each <u>Electricity Supplier</u> shall, in respect of each <u>Green Deal Plan</u> for which it is an agent and trustee, comply with all applicable <u>Green Deal Performance Levels</u>.
- 23.5. Where an <u>Electricity Supplier</u> fails to meet any <u>Green Deal Performance Level</u> applicable to it, the relevant <u>Green Deal Provider</u> or <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u> shall be entitled to the applicable <u>Green Deal Performance Level Compensation</u> from that <u>Electricity Supplier</u>, subject to <u>REC Performance Assurance Board</u> determination.
- 23.6. <u>Green Deal Performance Level Compensation</u> shall be the sole and exclusive remedy of other <u>Green Deal Users</u> for an <u>Electricity Supplier</u>'s failure to meet an applicable <u>Green Deal Performance Level</u>.

### **Quarterly Compliance Statement**

- 23.7. Where an <u>Electricity Supplier</u> is required to comply with a <u>Green Deal Performance Level</u> in any <u>Quarter</u>, it shall for that <u>Quarter</u>:
  - (a) acting as a Reasonable and Prudent Operator, monitor its performance against the <u>Green Deal Performance Levels</u>; and
  - (b) send a Quarterly Compliance Statement to the relevant <u>Green Deal Provider</u> or Green Deal Finance Party within 20 Working Days of the end of that Quarter.

#### **Audits**

23.8. The <u>REC Performance Assurance Board</u> shall determine whether to audit the accuracy of an <u>Electricity Supplier</u>'s Quarterly Compliance Statement, and may (at its sole discretion) do so on the application of any other <u>Green Deal User</u>.

#### **Decision by the REC Performance Assurance Board**

23.9. Any decision made by the <u>REC Performance Assurance Board</u> as to whether or not to carry out or procure an audit or to determine (under an audit) whether or not a Quarterly Compliance Statement is accurate shall be final and binding for the purposes of this <u>Code</u>.



23.10. Where, following the completion of an audit, the <a href="REC Performance Assurance Board">REC Performance Assurance Board</a> decides that a Quarterly Compliance Statement is inaccurate, the <a href="Electricity Supplier">Electricity Supplier</a> shall issue a corrected Quarterly Compliance Statement to the relevant <a href="Green Deal Finance Party">Green Deal Finance Party</a>, within 20 <a href="Working Day">Working Day</a>s.

#### Cost of audits

- 23.11. Where an audit is carried out, the relevant <u>Green Deal Users</u> shall co-operate fully (each at their own cost).
- 23.12. Where the <u>REC Performance Assurance Board</u> determines that the Quarterly Compliance Statement was:
  - (a) accurate, the relevant <u>Green Deal Provider</u> or <u>Green Deal Finance Party</u> shall pay <u>RECCo</u> costs of conducting or procuring the audit; or
  - (b) inaccurate, the relevant <u>Electricity Supplier</u> shall pay the <u>RECCo</u> costs of conducting or procuring the audit.

- 2.2 This Appendix should be updated if there is a change to the Processing of Personal Data which is undertaken in accordance with this REC Schedule.

#### 3 Data Controllers

3.1 The name and contact details of each <u>Data Controller</u> that is anticipated to Process <u>Personal Data</u> in accordance with this <u>REC Schedule</u> can be found at <u>www.gdorb.beis.gov.uk/data-controllers</u>.

#### 4 Purposes of Processing



- 4.1 <u>Personal Data</u> is Processed under this <u>REC Schedule</u> to fulfil the obligations on <u>Electricity Suppliers</u> and <u>Green Deal Providers</u> in relation to the operation of the <u>Green Deal</u> in accordance with the Energy Act 2011 and the <u>Green Deal Framework Regulations</u>.
- 4.2 <u>Electricity Suppliers</u> also Process <u>Personal Data</u> to fulfil obligations under their <u>Electricity Supply Licences</u>, and to fulfil their contractual arrangements with <u>Consumers</u>.
- 4.3 <u>Green Deal Providers</u> also Process <u>Personal Data</u> to fulfil their contractual arrangements with <u>Improvers</u> and <u>Green Deal Finance Parties</u>, and to comply with this <u>REC Schedule</u>.
- 4.4 <u>Green Deal Finance Parties</u> and <u>Green Deal Remittance Processors</u> also Process <u>Personal Data</u> to fulfil their contractual arrangements with other <u>Green Deal Users</u>, and to comply with this <u>REC Schedule</u>.
- 4.5 <u>RECCo</u> also Processes <u>Personal Data</u> in fulfilling its obligations under this <u>Code</u> to make the <u>Green Deal Central Charging Database</u> available.
- 4.6 The <u>Code Manager</u> also Processes <u>Personal Data</u> in fulfilling its obligations under this <u>Code</u> to admit and manage <u>Green Deal Users</u> and provide reports.

#### 5 Nature of Processing

- 5.1 The nature of the Processing under this <u>REC Schedule</u> encompasses the collection, storage and transmission of <u>Personal Data</u>:
  - (a) by the <u>Code Manager</u> of <u>Personal Data</u> that: (i) is received from <u>Green Deal Users</u> and prospective <u>Green Deal Users</u> in relation to the management of Qualification as a <u>Green Deal User</u>, and ongoing Processing in relation to the general duties of the <u>Code Manager</u> under and in relation to this <u>REC Schedule</u>; or (ii) relates to <u>Green Deal Plans</u> and is used in relation to generation of reports to the <u>REC Board</u> and <u>Green Deal Users</u> in accordance with this <u>Code</u>;
  - (b) by <u>RECCo</u> in relation to Processing undertaken in making the <u>Green Deal</u> <u>Central Charging Database</u> available, and complying with its obligations under this Code;
  - (c) by <u>Green Deal Providers</u> of <u>Personal Data</u> in relation to a <u>Consumer</u> where the <u>Consumer</u>: (i) wishes to enter into a <u>Green Deal Plan</u>; (ii) is an <u>Improver</u>; (iii) is or has been a <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u>; or (iv) is or has been a



#### Default Bill Payer;

- (d) by <u>Electricity Suppliers</u> of <u>Personal Data</u> in relation to a <u>Consumer</u> where the <u>Consumer</u>: (i) wishes to enter into a <u>Green Deal Plan</u>; (ii) is an <u>Improver</u>; (iii) is or has been a <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u>; or (iv) is or has been a <u>Default Bill Payer</u>;
- (e) collected from <u>Improvers</u> by <u>Green Deal Providers</u> at a premises where the relevant <u>Improver</u> wishes to enter into a <u>Green Deal Plan</u>, and is not the <u>Consumer</u>;
- (f) collected from <u>Default Bill Payers</u> by <u>Green Deal Users</u> where those <u>Default Bill Payers</u>' are not the <u>Consumer</u>;
- (g) relating to <u>Green Deal Bill Payers</u> and <u>Default Bill Payers</u> collected by <u>Green Deal Finance Parties</u> from those <u>Green Deal Bill Payers</u> and <u>Default Bill Payers</u>, or from <u>Green Deal Providers</u> or <u>Electricity Suppliers</u>; and
- (h) in relation to the recovery and remittance of Green Deal Charges.

#### 6 Duration of Processing

- 6.1 In relation to <u>Personal Data</u> Processed by the <u>Code Manager</u>, Processing will take place for the duration of this <u>Code</u>.
- 6.2 In relation to <u>Personal Data</u> Processed in relation to a <u>Green Deal Plan</u>, the data will be Processed for the duration of the <u>Green Deal Plan</u> or until all payments in relation to that <u>Green Deal Plan</u> have been made or written-off (as the case may be).

## 7 Categories of **Data Subjects**

- 7.1 Categories of <u>Data Subjects</u> in respect of the <u>Personal Data</u> processed in accordance with this <u>REC Schedule</u> are:

  - (a) Electricity Account Number;
  - (b) EPC Reference Number;
  - (c) EPC Report Reference;
  - (d) Green Deal Plan ID;
  - (e) Green Deal MPAN Core;
  - (f) Premises addresses for Green Deal Bill Payers and Default Bill Payers;
  - (g) Full names of Green Deal Bill Payers and Default Bill Payers;
  - (h) Telephone numbers for <u>Green Deal Bill Payers</u>; and <u>Default Bill Payers</u>;
  - (i) Amounts of Green Deal Charges payable, on a daily or aggregate basis;
  - (j) GD Energy Payment Frequency;
  - (k) GD Energy Payment Method.
- 8.4 No special categories of Personal Data are Processed under this REC Schedule.
- 9 Sources of Personal Data
- 9.1 The sources of Personal Data Processed comprise:
  - (a) Green Deal Providers

- (c) Green Deal Remittance Processors; and
- (d) Green Deal Finance Parties.

## 10 Recipients of Personal Data

  - (b) Electricity Suppliers
  - (c) Distribution Network Operators;
  - (d) Gas Suppliers;
  - (e) Green Deal Finance Parties;
  - (f) Green Deal Remittance Processors;
  - (g) the Secretary of State (BEIS);
  - (h) RECCo; and
  - (i) the Code Manager

#### 11 Retention of Personal Data

- 11.1 In relation to <u>Personal Data</u> Processed by the <u>Code Manager</u>, all records will be retained for a maximum period of seven (7) years after this <u>Code</u> ends.
- 11.2 In relation to <u>Personal Data</u> Processed in relation to a <u>Green Deal Plan</u>, records will be retained for a maximum period of seven (7) years after the relevant Green Deal Plan End Date.

## Appendix 2: Green Deal Charges – Amounts to Recover and Remit

## 1 Methods of Payment

1.1 Payment following receipt of a bill

Where a Green Deal Bill Payer pays Charges following the receipt of a bill from its



## Supplier:

- (a) the <u>Green Deal Charges</u> to be recovered by the Supplier under each bill shall be:
  - i. the sum of the relevant Daily <u>Green Deal Charges</u> for the billing period to which the bill relates;
  - ii. plus any underpayment and minus any overpayment of <u>Green Deal</u> <u>Charges</u> under previous bills;
- (b) the Remittance Date(s) shall be a date that is either:
  - i. as soon as reasonably practicable, but not more than 3 <u>Working</u> <u>Days</u> after receiving the amount under paragraph 1.1(a) in Cleared Funds (save that, if such amount cannot be allocated to the Green Deal Bill Payer's Account on the day of receipt, then the Supplier shall allocate the <u>Remittance Amount</u> as soon as reasonably practicable after receipt and the <u>Remittance Date</u> shall be a date, chosen at the Supplier's discretion, that is as soon as reasonably practicable, but not more than 3 <u>Working Day</u>s of the date on which allocation occurs); or
  - ii. (where there is an opening credit balance on the Green Deal Bill Payer's Account at the time the bill was issued) as soon as reasonably practicable, but not more than 3 <u>Working Day</u>s after the bill has been issued and (chosen at the Supplier's discretion):
  - such opening credit balance is greater than zero pounds at the time the bill was issued; or
  - such opening credit balance is greater than twenty pounds (£20) at the time the bill was issued;
- (c) the Remittance Amount shall, subject to paragraph 2, be an amount equivalent to the amount collected under paragraph 1.1(a); and
- (d) the parties acknowledge that where there is a credit balance on the Green Deal Bill Payer's Account at the time a bill is issued, the operation of



paragraph 1.1(b)(ii) may result in there being two different Remittance Dates following the collection of Charges under that bill.

1.2 Scheme of fixed payment amount and frequency

Where a <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> pays Charges by way of a scheme of fixed payment amount and frequency:

- (e) the <u>Green Deal Charges</u> to be recovered by the Supplier at the time the Supplier collects <u>Charges for the Supply of Electricity</u> shall be:
  - i. the sum of the relevant Daily <u>Green Deal Charges</u> over the relevant assessment period plus any underpayment or minus any overpayment of <u>Green Deal Charges</u> in relation to previous assessment periods;
  - ii. divided by the number of scheme payments to be made within that assessment period;
- (f) the <u>Remittance Date</u> shall be a date, chosen at the Supplier's discretion, that as soon as reasonably practicable but not more than 3 <u>Working Day</u>s after receiving the amount collected under paragraph 1.2(a) in Cleared Funds; and
- (g) the <u>Remittance Amount</u> shall, at the relevant Supplier's choice (to be made once for each <u>Green Deal Plan</u>), but subject to paragraph 2, either be:
  - i. an amount equivalent to the amount collected under paragraph 1.2(a); or
  - ii. an amount equivalent to the sum of the Daily <u>Green Deal Charges</u> for the period from the date of the previous <u>Remittance Date</u> to the current <u>Remittance Date</u>.

## 1.3 Third Party Deductions Scheme

Where a <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> pays Charges by way of the Third Party Deductions Scheme:

- (a) the <u>Green Deal Charges</u> to be recovered by the Supplier at the time the Supplier collects <u>Charges for the Supply of Electricity</u> shall be:
  - i. the sum of the relevant Daily <u>Green Deal Charges</u> over the relevant assessment period as adjusted by any underpayment or overpayment



- of Green Deal Charges in relation to previous assessment periods;
- ii. divided by the number of scheme payments to be made within that assessment period;
- (b) the <u>Remittance Date</u> shall be a date, chosen at the Supplier's discretion, that is as soon as reasonably practicable, but not more than 3 <u>Working Days</u> after receiving Cleared Funds from the Department of Work and Pensions (or such person acting on its behalf under the Third Party Deductions Scheme); and
- (c) the Remittance Amount shall, subject to paragraph 2, be an amount equivalent to the amount collected under paragraph 1.3.3(a).

## 1.4 Prepayment Meters

- 1.4.1 Where a Green Deal Bill Payer pays Charges by way of Prepayment Meter:
  - (a) subject to paragraph 1.4.2, the <u>Remittance Amount</u> shall be an amount equivalent to the sum of:
    - i. the relevant Daily <u>Green Deal Charges</u> either, at the relevant Supplier's choice (to be made once for each <u>Green Deal Plan</u>), summed:
    - over the relevant month; or
    - over the period from the date of the previous <u>Remittance Date</u> to the current <u>Remittance Date</u>; and
      - ii. (subject to paragraph 2.5) <u>Green Deal Charges</u> arrears collected, and, as between that Supplier and that <u>Green Deal Provider</u> only, such amount shall be treated as a Green Deal Charge recovered by the Supplier (and for the avoidance of doubt that remittance shall not discharge the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u>'s obligation to pay the Green Deal Charge);
  - (b) the <u>Remittance Date</u> shall be on a <u>Working Day</u> in each month, chosen at the relevant Supplier's discretion, to be made once per <u>Green Deal Plan</u>; and



(c) the Supplier may recover such amount from the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> as a debt in accordance with section 1(6)(c) of the Energy Act and upon such recovery may reimburse itself from that amount for the sums paid out under paragraph 1.4.1(a) above with no further obligation under section 1(6)(d) of the Energy Act.

## 1.4.2 Where the Supplier has:

- (a) evidence to reasonably conclude that the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> is not purchasing credit at a vending system and there is no credit balance on the <u>Prepayment Meter</u>; or
- (b) has issued a Notice to a <u>Green Deal Provider</u> under Clause 10.1.7(b) and has been unable to apply <u>Green Deal Charges</u> on the <u>Prepayment Meter</u>,

the <u>Remittance Amount</u> shall, for the relevant period, be zero the <u>Remittance Amount</u> shall be zero but Daily <u>Green Deal Charges</u> shall still continue to accrue and the obligation to recover <u>Green Deal Charges</u> from the relevant <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> does not end.

- 1.4.3 For the purposes of paragraph 1.4.1(a)(ii), an amount:
  - (a) assigned by an Old Supplier to a New Supplier pursuant to Standard Condition 14.6 (Domestic Customer transfer blocking) of an <u>Electricity Supply Licence</u>, shall be treated as arrears for <u>Charges for the Supply of Electricity</u>; and
  - (b) received by the Old Supplier in consideration for the assignment to a New Supplier of <u>Outstanding Charges</u>, pursuant to Standard Condition 14.6 (Domestic Customer transfer blocking) of an <u>Electricity Supply Licence</u>, shall be treated as arrears collected by that Supplier, subject to a maximum reduction in the <u>Outstanding Charges</u> that are <u>Green Deal Charges</u> of twenty pounds sterling (£20) per occasion.
- 1.4.4 The arrangement in paragraph 1.4.1 above is agreed by the parties to satisfy the requirements of section 1(6) of the Energy Act.
- 1.5 Other payment methods
- 1.5.1 Where a <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> pays Charges by way of a payment method not specified above (a non-specified payment method), but the provisions in paragraph 1.1, 1.2, 1.3 or 1.4 work for such payment method, such paragraph shall apply to that payment method.



- 1.5.2 Where a non-specified payment method is such that the provisions in Paragraph 1.1, 1.2, 1.3 or 1.4 do not work for such payment method, the relevant Supplier shall raise a <a href="Change Proposal">Change Proposal</a> under Clause 7.2 for the purposes of the Panel agreeing changes to this Agreement for the remittance of <a href="Green Deal Charges">Green Deal Charges</a> paid using that payment method.
- 1.5.3 Where a Supplier is under an obligation to raise a <u>Change Proposal</u> under paragraph 1.5.2, until such changes to this Agreement are agreed for the relevant payment method:
  - (a) the <u>Green Deal Charges</u> to recover shall be the sum of the relevant Daily <u>Green Deal Charges</u> for the period to which the <u>Charges for the Supply of Electricity</u> relate, as adjusted by any prior underpayment or overpayment of <u>Green Deal Charges</u> by that <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u>;
  - (b) the <u>Remittance Date</u> shall be a date, chosen at the Supplier's discretion, that is as soon as reasonably practicable but not more than three (3) <u>Working</u> Days after it receives Cleared Funds; and
  - (c) the <u>Remittance Amount</u> shall be an amount equivalent to the amount collected under paragraph 1.5.3(a).

#### 2 Overpayment and partial payment

#### 2.1 Overpayments

- 2.1.1 Where a Supplier, acting in compliance with its obligations under this Agreement, collects more than the Expected Amount from a <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u>, then such excess amount shall be an overpayment for the purposes of the calculation of the next Expected Amount under paragraph 1.
- 2.1.2 Subject to Clause 11.8.3, where a <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> requests a refund of an excess amount referred to under paragraph 2.1.1, the relevant Supplier shall be responsible for refunding that excess amount to that <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> (irrespective of whether it has already been remitted under Clause 12.2.1(a)).
- 2.1.3 For the avoidance of doubt, where a Supplier recovers <u>Green Deal Charges</u> from an Electricity <u>Consumer</u> that relate to a period during which there was an Erroneous Registration:
  - (a) such <u>Green Deal Charges</u> shall not be interpreted as being Expected Amounts; and



(b) where such <u>Green Deal Charges</u> (in whole or in part) have been remitted to a <u>Green Deal Provider</u> under Clause 12, they shall be excess amounts referred to under Paragraph 2.1.1.

## 2.2 Equivalence

- 2.2.1 For the purposes of this paragraph 2.2, a Payment is an amount collected by a Supplier in any of the following circumstances:
  - (a) the Supplier, acting in compliance with its obligations under this Agreement, collects some (but not all) of the Charges due from a <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> for the relevant period;
  - (b) a <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> has <u>Outstanding Charges</u> and makes an ad hoc payment to the Supplier; or
  - (c) a <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> pays a Security Deposit to the Supplier (requested by the Supplier in accordance with its <u>Electricity Supply Licence</u>) and such Security Deposit (or part thereof) is used to settle all or some of the Charges due from a <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u>.
- 2.2.2 Where a Payment is collected under an Electricity Supply Contract (other than one falling within Paragraph 2.2.3), then for the purposes of Clause 12.2.1(a) (but subject to paragraph 1.4.3) Charges for the Supply of Electricity and Green Deal Charges (or, where applicable, such ad hoc payment or valid payment of Charges from the Security Deposit) shall rank equally without any preference between them, irrespective of how the Green Deal Bill Payer intends or instructs how the Charges should be treated or dealt with.
- 2.2.3 Where a Payment is collected under a Non-Domestic Electricity Supply Contract and the <u>Charges for the Supply of Electricity</u> relate to more than one <u>Non-Domestic Premises</u> but the relevant <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> has expressed an intention or instruction that its payment of such <u>Charges for the Supply of Electricity</u> is for one or more (but not all) of those <u>Non-Domestic Premises</u>, then for the purposes of Clause 12.2.1(a) <u>Charges for the Supply of Electricity</u> and <u>Green Deal Charges</u> (or, where applicable, such ad hoc payment or valid payment of Charges from the Security Deposit) shall rank equally any preference between them (at the relevant Supplier's choice, to be made once per Non-Domestic Contract) either:
  - (a) to all Non-Domestic Premises which the Charges related to; or
  - (b) to those <u>Non-Domestic Premises</u> in relation to which the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> expressed its intention or instruction.



- 2.2.4 For the purposes of this paragraph 2.2, references to "Charges for the Supply of Electricity" shall be interpreted as:
  - (a) inclusive of VAT and Climate Change Levy (to the extent they are chargeable to the relevant Electricity Customer on the supply of electricity);
  - (b) exclusive of interest and late payment fees payable in connection with the relevant Charges for the Supply of Electricity;
  - (c) net of any reduction or credit and any VAT thereon (including any discount, rebate or loyalty payment) received by the Electricity Customer against the amount payable in connection with the relevant Charges for the Supply of Electricity;
  - (d) either inclusive or exclusive of amounts charged to the Electricity Customer other than under the Electricity Supply Contract (but on the same bill or demand for payment as the bill or demand for Charges for the Supply of Electricity), in each case to be determined in accordance with the same approach ordinarily used by the relevant Supplier when it receives part payment from an Electricity Customer following receipt of a bill or demand for payment that includes Charges for the Supply of Electricity and other charges (and for the avoidance of doubt, the Supplier must use the same approach for the purposes of this paragraph).

## 2.3 Ad hoc payments

2.3.1 Where a <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> pays Charges on an ad hoc basis (but not falling within paragraphs 1.1 to 1.5 above) and there is a debit balance on the Green Deal Bill Payer's Account at the time the payment is made, the <u>Remittance Date</u> shall be as soon as reasonably practicable, but not more than three (3) <u>Working Days</u> after receiving Cleared Funds (save that, if the <u>Remittance Amount</u> cannot be allocated to the Green Deal Bill Payer's Account on the day of receipt, then the Supplier shall allocate the <u>Remittance Amount</u> as soon as reasonably practicable after receipt and the <u>Remittance Date</u> shall be a date, chosen at the Supplier's discretion, that is as soon as reasonably practicable, but not more than three (3) <u>Working Days</u> of the date on which allocation occurs).

## 2.4 Pre-Green Deal Charges for the Supply of Electricity

Paragraphs 2.1, 2.2 and 2.3 shall not apply to <u>Charges for the Supply of Electricity</u> and Security Deposits for the period preceding the first <u>Green Deal Charge Start</u> Date of the relevant <u>Green Deal Plan</u>.



#### 2.5 Payment of oldest debt first

The Supplier may (at its discretion) apply monies received from a <u>Green Deal Bill</u> <u>Payer</u> in discharge of arrears of Charges for that <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> in the order in which they accrued.

## 2.6 Rounding

The Parties acknowledge and agree that:

- (a) the value of each Daily Green Deal Charge shall be recorded to two decimal places; and
- (b) all internal calculations of <u>Remittance Amount</u>s under this Agreement shall be made to no fewer than four (4) decimal places,

and the value for each <u>Remittance Amount</u> so calculated shall be rounded to the second (2nd) decimal, for which purposes a figure of five zero (50) in the third decimal shall result in it being rounded up.

#### **Appendix 3: Supplier Performance Levels**

## 1 Supplier Performance Levels

Where this Schedule applies, Parts A, B and C shall apply in accordance with their terms below.

#### Part A – Billing frequency

The <u>Performance Levels</u> in this Part A shall apply where the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> is obliged to pay <u>Green Deal Charges</u> following the receipt of a bill from the relevant <u>Electricity Supplier</u> (which shall be determined solely by reference to item "GD Energy Payment Method" in the relevant Provide Remittance Details Market Message).

Evidence of the billing frequency specified in the table below shall be determined solely by reference to item "GD Energy Payment Frequency" in the relevant Provide Remittance Details Market Message.

Following receipt of a bill (annually)	Send a bill to the <u>Green</u> <u>Deal Bill Payer</u> at least every 392 calendar days	95% of all cases in each Quarter	Interest on Expected Amount

\*Where, for a <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u>, the electricity meter reading submitted to the relevant <u>Electricity Supplier</u> is outside that <u>Electricity Supplier</u>'s tolerance for the purposes of sending an accurate bill to that <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u>, the number of calendar days set out in the relevant Performance Description shall be extended by 30 calendar days. This extension shall apply a maximum of once per billing period.

## Part B – Dunning collection processes

The <u>Performance Level</u> in this Part B shall apply where the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> owes <u>Outstanding Charges</u> that are <u>Green Deal Charges</u>.

The <u>Performance Levels</u> in this Part B relating to "Reminder Notices" shall apply where the <u>Green Deal Bill Payer</u> is obliged to pay <u>Green Deal Charges</u> following the receipt of a bill from the relevant <u>Electricity Supplier</u> (which shall be determined solely by reference to the data in the <u>Remittance Information</u> which reflects the Green Deal Payer's current method for payment of <u>Charges for the Supply of Electricity</u> and <u>Green Deal Charges</u>).

The Performance Level in this Part C shall apply in all cases.

## 2 Performance Level Compensation

For each case where an <u>Electricity Supplier</u> fails to meet a <u>Performance Level</u> applicable to it in paragraph 1 of this Appendix, the relevant compensation to be calculated by reference to the column headed "Compensation" for that <u>Performance Level</u>, shall be as follows:



## **Interest on Expected Amount**

The <u>Performance Level Compensation</u> shall be equivalent to the interest payable on the Expected Amount at the annual <u>Relevant Interest Rate</u> (as calculated on the last day of that <u>Quarter</u>), compounded daily from and including the last date that the <u>Performance Level</u> was capable of being achieved until, but excluding, the date that the relevant bill was sent.

#### **Interest on Remittance Amount**

The <u>Performance Level Compensation</u> shall be equivalent to the annual <u>Relevant Interest Rate</u> (as calculated on the last day of that <u>Quarter</u>) payable on the <u>Remittance Amount</u>, compounded daily from and including the Due Date until, but excluding, the date payment is made. For avoidance of doubt, the <u>Electricity Supplier</u> shall not be subject to double recovery under Paragraph 23.6 and this Appendix.

#### Loss of Quarterly Payment

The Performance Level Compensation shall be equivalent to:

- (a) (where the <u>Electricity Supplier</u> is a <u>Mandatory Green Deal Supplier</u>) the Mandatory Supplier <u>Quarterly Payment</u> in the <u>Quarter</u> pro-rated to the number of that <u>Electricity Supplier</u>'s <u>Mandatory</u> Supplier Relevant Plans during that <u>Quarter</u> for which the <u>Electricity Supplier</u> was late in meeting the <u>Performance Level</u>.
- (b) (where the <u>Electricity Supplier</u> is a <u>Voluntary Green Deal Supplier</u>) the Voluntary Supplier <u>Quarterly Payment</u> in the <u>Quarter</u> pro-rated to the number of that <u>Electricity Supplier</u>'s <u>Voluntary</u> Supplier Relevant Plans during that <u>Quarter</u> for which the <u>Electricity Supplier</u> was late in meeting the <u>Performance Level</u>.
