Programme Updates

MHHS Programme Planning Dialogue Session: 11.30-13.00, 12 September 2024

The Programme is undertaking scenario and contingency planning activities to assess the impact of the slower pace of testing on downstream Programme milestones, such as the system and code change 'go-live' Milestone 10 (M10) and Milestone 8 (M8).

A programme Change Request is expected to be issued to industry for impact assessment on **23 September 2024**. Prior to this, the Programme are holding a dialogue session to walk industry participants through the proposed updates to the MHHS Programme Plan. This should enable participants to begin any internal planning activities in advance of the IA window.

The session is at 11:30-13:00 on 12 September 2024.

MHHS Qualification Pre-Integration Testing (PIT) Evidence Obfuscation

Code Bodies are aware that Live MPANs may be used for Non-SIT PIT Qualification Testing. Code Bodies would like to remind participants that MPANs are considered Personal Identifiable Information (PII) and cannot be shared in Test Reports, Evidence, Logs, or Images shared for PIT evidence review.

It is the participant's responsibility to ensure all evidence shared with the Qualification Testing Team and Code Bodies is properly anonymised/obfuscated whilst ensuring that the content can be verified. The Code Bodies have published guidance, including an example diagram, which is available on the Qualification PIT Evidence Obfuscation page of the MHHS website.
