Prepayment Levelisation Webinar

Work continues to end the prepayment premium

Energy consumers in the UK who use prepayment meters have historically been charged more for their energy than those who pay via direct debit. Following selection by Ofgem, RECCo are developing systems and processes to levelise energy bills between prepayment meter and direct debit customers.

On the 30 November, RECCo, alongside representatives from Ofgem and Capgemini, held a progress webinar to confirm when the new levelisation system will be implemented, how the scheme will operate, the changes being made to REC legal text, the latest data reporting requirements, and to answer key questions.

Request for Information: R0082

The Code Manager has issued a Request for information (RFI) on Change Proposal [R0082 - Formalising the Submission of PPMIP Unallocated Transaction Report \(UTR\) Files](#).

This RFI will be used to understand which PPMIPs are using which file types and the usefulness of the additional data items from MAP C0339. This will determine how the Code Manager progresses the change.

R0148 - Introduction of classification-based access model into the REC in support of Open Data

[R0148 - Introduction of classification-based access model into the REC in support of Open Data](#) involves the categorisation of data within the Enquiry Services which will help to improve, extend, and simplify access to data securely and efficiently. These will be 4 categories of Closed, Personal, Conditionally Open and Always Open.

Part of this Change Proposal will be to introduce a metadata catalogue which categorises each Data Item within the Enquiry Services. The Code Manager is requesting that industry review the proposed categorisation of the Data Items and an overview of how this should be completed can be found [here](#). Once the review is finalised, it can be uploaded to the Portal on the relevant Party Impact Assessment page [here](#).

This request was flagged to RIG Members at the meeting on 10 November 2023 and there were concerns raised over the size of the request and that ample time must be provided to ensure the right resource can conduct this review. The Code Manager has taken this feedback on board and extended the Impact Assessment period to 26 January 2024.

Please submit response by **23:59** on **26 January 2024**.
