Change of Tenancy Change Proposal (R0155) Working Group

<u>R0155</u> has been raised by RECCo with the intention of reviewing the non-domestic Change of Tenancy process, including Change of Supplier with a Change of Tenancy. The review has no set solution and is looking for input from Suppliers, Third Party Intermediaries and Consumers through a working group and the REC Change Process.

Prior to the formal establishment of the working group to develop the potential solution for the change, the Code Manager is hosting two online webinars – one for Suppliers and one for Third Party Intermediaries. These sessions will introduce the Code Manager's plan for the subsequent working group activity, including how that working group would be established and members appointed.

Both sessions will commence at 14:00 and are expected to last approximately two hours.

R0147 Prepayment Levelisation Readiness

The Levelisation Policy developed by Ofgem is being targeted for introduction via Licence Condition amendments to be effective from 01 April 2024. RECCo will be responsible for the introduction and ongoing administration of the supporting Payment Method Levelisation (PML) Reconciliation via the Retail Energy Code.

REC Change Proposal <u>R0147 - Prepayment Levelisation</u> was raised to progress the necessary changes to the REC, setting out how PML Reconciliation will operate and the obligations on RECCo and Domestic Suppliers. The Change Proposal is targeted for implementation on **28 March 2024**.

R0043 - Authority Approval

On 15 January 2024, Ofgem approved the Change Proposal <u>R0043 – Commissioning of Works by the</u> <u>Crowded Meter Room Coordinator (CMRC) to Resolve Issues in Crowded Meter Rooms</u>.

This change will help support more than 5,000 shared residential buildings in the UK to being made 'Smart Ready', providing more than 100,000 households that were not previously eligible for a smart meter due to technical installation challenges the opportunity to finally access the technology.

Following the implementation of R0043, the REC will now allow for the commissioning of these works in residential buildings supplied by multiple different energy suppliers, allowing for MEMs to efficiently deliver the solution provided by SMS and Alt Han to ensure that such buildings can be made Smart Ready.

The Change Proposal is now set for implementation on 28 June 2024.
