Change of Tenancy Change Proposal (R0155) Working Group

R0155 has been raised by RECCo with the intention of reviewing the non-domestic Change of Tenancy process, including Change of Supplier with a Change of Tenancy. The review has no set solution and is looking for input from Suppliers, Third Party Intermediaries (TPIs) and Consumers through a working group and the REC Change Process.

On 25 January 2024, the Code Manager met with Suppliers to introduce the Code Manager's plan for the next stages working group activity, including how the working group will be established and members appointed.

On 01 February 2024 (14:00 - 16:00), the Code Manager will meet with TPIs to provide the same overview. TPIs are invited to sign up to attend this online session by emailing enquiries@recmanager.co.uk before 31 January 2024.

Market Half Hourly Settlement (MHHS) - New Working Groups

From February 2024, The TMAG will be replaced by SIT, Qualification and Migration Advisory Groups.

We've confirmed the first meeting dates and regular cadence for each of these new groups:

- Systems Integration Testing Advisory Group (SITAG) the first meeting is on Wednesday 21 February 2024 and further meetings will be on the third Wednesday of each month.
- Qualification Advisory Group (QAG) the first meeting is on Thursday 22 February 2024 and further meetings will be on the third Thursday of each month.
- Migration & Cutover Advisory Group (MCAG) the first meeting is on Tuesday 27 February 2024 and further meetings will be on the fourth Tuesday of each month.

R0147 Prepayment Levelisation Readiness

The Levelisation Policy developed by Ofgem is being targeted for introduction via Licence Condition amendments to be effective from 01 April 2024. RECCo will be responsible for the introduction and ongoing administration of the supporting Payment Method Levelisation (PML) Reconciliation via the Retail Energy Code.

REC Change Proposal <u>R0147 - Prepayment Levelisation</u> was raised to progress the necessary changes to the REC, setting out how PML Reconciliation will operate and the obligations on RECCo and Domestic Suppliers. The Change Proposal is targeted for implementation on **28 March 2024**.

Balance and Settlement Code (BSC) – Issue 101 Consultation

The REC Code Manager would like to highlight the upcoming BSC Issue 101 Consultation to all REC Participants.

The BSC are seeking views from potential Data Integration Platform (DIP) Users and other interested parties on the proposed arrangements and drafting for the enduring governance, funding and operation of the DIP. The arrangements, legal text and subsidiary documents have been developed by Elexon as part of Issue 101 'Ongoing Governance, Funding and Operation of the Market-wide Half Hourly Settlement (MHHS) DIP by BSCCo'.

The DIP is a vital technical component of the transition to MHHS that will be used to share data including Half-Hourly consumption data from consumers' smart meters. Ofgem have tasked Elexon with proposing the future governance arrangements for the DIP; Issue 101 was raised to gather industry input to help develop the arrangements. This consultation on the proposed arrangements and drafting for the DIP is to allow for industry engagement prior to the drafting being implemented as part of an Authority-led Significant Code Review Modification.
