# C3-0083 – SDEP User Guide Updates

<u>R0121 – SDEP Review Improvements – Process Types</u> has been approved for implementation on **23 August 2024** and introduces new Secure Data Exchange use cases (Process Types).

The Code Manager is updating the Secure Data Exchange Portal (SDEP) User Guide to align with the new Process Types and to review it more generally through C3-0083 – SDEP User Guide Updates.

This Category 3 Change Proposal seeks to create a comprehensive overview describing the intended/best practice use of all SDEP Process Types to ensure that queries are raised correctly and therefore can be resolved more easily.

Industry feedback is sought on the draft updates to the SDEP User Guide through the <u>Consultations</u> Register on the REC Portal.

**All DTN users must update the Catalogue in their systems**, regardless of their involvement in MHHS testing. Please note that this Catalogue does not include any change to the Operational flows.

Only MHHS SIT participants will need to make material changes to their systems in response to this Catalogue update. Programme participants who are not participating in MHHS SIT will not need to make any material system changes in response to this Catalogue update.
