Creating user permissions for new SDEP Process Types

As part of the implementation of Change Proposal <u>R0121 - SDEP Review Improvements (1) - Process</u> <u>Types</u> in August 2024, we are running a one-off exercise to update the permissions of new/existing users of the Secure Data Exchange Portal (SDEP) for the new Process Types (use cases). All registered SDEP Master Administrative Users (MAU) are being contacted directly in the next few days and offered the opportunity to provide user details by close of play on **08 July 2024**.

We are providing a template to populate with details of users you wish to assign access permissions for the new Process Types. If you don't wish to participate, you will be able to register the relevant users after the August release, via the usual process in the SDEP.

We are also providing supporting information about the Process Types to help you determine which team members you wish to assign permissions to.

Electricity Enquiry Service (EES) API

The Market-Wide Half Hourly Settlement (MHHS) design introduces a number of changes to data items that are held within the Electricity Enquiry Service (EES), both the Portal and the API. Required changes to the EES API are detailed in the MHHS version of the <u>EES API Interface Specification</u> agreed through the MHHS Programme Code Drafting process. These changes will impact **all EES Users**, including those not otherwise impacted by MHHS.

The MHHS version of the EES API will go-live as part of the MHHS Programme Milestone M10, alongside other central system changes. This is currently planned for **07 March 2025**.

Test versions of the updated API will be made available through the following routes:

MHHS Programme Systems Integration Testing (SIT) Testing (SIT Parties only)

A test version of the EES API will be made available in the MHHS SIT A environment from 10 June 2024 to support MHHS SIT Migration. SIT Parties requiring access to this test version of the API should contact the MHHS Programme Testing Team via testing@mhhsprogramme.co.uk.

Supporting Programme UIT Testing (All Parties)

A test version of the EES API will be made available for all EES Users in conjunction with MHHS Programme User Integration Testing (UIT) from 31 October 2024.
