Migration Testing within SIT has now started following a decision at the extraordinary Systems Integration Testing (SITAG) meeting on 17 June 2024 to approve Milestone T3-TE-0038: SIT Migration Testing Start, subject to work-off requirements.

On 13 June 2024, the Programme published the second suite of MHHS Migration Framework Artefacts for industry consultation. This consultation mainly focuses on monitoring and controlling Migration Execution, having focused on developing, initialising and maintaining the Migration Schedule in the first Migration Framework consultation.
