Any party that receives a message directly from Central Switching Service (CSS) and needs to validate its authenticity will need a copy of the latest CSS JWS (Public) Production signing certificate. Action is required by **20 February 2024, (07 Working Days)**. The JWS Certificate is issued to digitally sign each message and validates that the message sender is authenticated and the message integrity. Each CSS User that receives messages from CSS will need to install the updated certificate to ensure messages can still be authenticated. This [Portal page](#) provides further details.
