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April 2024 Extraordinary REC Release

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The April 2024 Extraordinary REC Release will be implemented next week, on 12 April 2024. For further information, the Release Plan is available on the Release Management page of the REC Portal.

The REC Baseline statement will also be updated to reflect the new version numbers of the updated products and will be implemented as part of the April 2024 Release.

R0063 Delays

Following CSS go-live, DNOs were unable to resolve some tickets sent to them by the CSS Provider, as they did not include critical information such as which MPAN the issue related to. The REC Performance Assurance Board (PAB) approved a derogation (Derogation 10) relating to this, which established a workaround between DNOs and DCC.

R0063 (Addition of key information to all Service Now tickets) was a change raised to enable the critical information to be automatically included within a ticket at the point at which it is created, removing the need for the workaround. This change was scheduled for release on 12 April 2024. Delays in the technical development of this change were raised late to the Code Manager, and subsequently the technical implementation of R0063 will be delayed until 28 June 2024. The change to the REC will still take place as planned on 12 April 2024.

The Code Manager will communicate before this technical change is implemented in June to provide DNOs the information needed, as well as including information on this in release documentation.

The performance of REC Service Providers is governed by the REC PAB, a committee which includes representation from all types of REC Party including DNOs. This committee has taken action to address the performance of DCC, as we acknowledge the significant impact delays like this can have on REC Parties and other users of REC Services.

Information provided to PAB has been included in this <u>paper</u>, and the decisions taken are set out in the <u>PAB headline</u> report.

As this technical change will be delayed, the PAB also extended the derogation for DNOs. We would therefore ask you to continue with the workaround activities that you have in place in relation to these events. The Code Manager will continue to focus on driving up standards of REC Service Provision in its Performance Assurance work to reduce these impacts as much as possible.

Pre-Qualification Submission

All Non-SIT Suppliers, Agents, and New Entrant DNOs (referred to as LDSOs in the MHHS Programme) Programme Participants are required to provide a Pre-Qualification Submission (PQS) for MHHS Qualification. The PQS window opened on 05 February 2024 and final submissions are due by 17:00 on **26 April 2024**.

The submission includes all the information that Code Bodies need to make an informed judgement on a party's readiness and suitability to be allocated to a particular Qualification Wave. Participants are expected to submit their Pre-Integration Testing (PIT) Approach and Plan as supporting evidence for their PQS submission.

Please note that SIT participants are not expected to submit the PQS for the roles and Market Participant IDs (MPIDs) they are participating with in SIT. Existing LDSOs participating in Non-SIT LDSO Qualification are also not expected to submit the PQS.

The Code Bodies are hosting drop-in sessions for participants who require further support in completing their PQS. The sessions are open to all participants completing the PQS and they will be recorded and published on the Collaboration Base. Following the drop-in session that was hosted on 04 April 2024, the PQS Webinar Q&A document, which is available on the MHHS Webinars & Open Days page of the MHHS website, will be updated to support participants with completing their PQS.
