# Consultation: Qualification Approach & Plan: Annex 1 Non-Functional and Operational Testing Updates, due 03 May 2024

Annex 1 of the Qualification Approach and Plan has been updated to include details on Non-Functional and Operational testing and has been published for consultation.

Annex 1 is specific to Distribution Network Operators (known as LDSOs in the MHHS Programme) who are not participating in MHHS Systems Integration Testing (SIT). As the scope of Non-Functional testing between Non-SIT LDSO Qualification Testing and Non-SIT Supplier and Agent Qualification Testing will be similar, Suppliers and Agents may also wish to review the updates.

### Consultation: Cutover Plan for M10 (Central systems go live) /M11 (Start of migration), due 07 May 2024

On 23 April 2024, the MHHS Programme published the M10/M11 Cutover Plan for industry consultation. The M10/M11 Cutover Plan sets out the activities that MHHS participants will be required to carry out:

- in the lead up to M10 when Central systems will be ready for the migration
- at M10, and
- between M10 and M11 when migration will start

These activities will enable the Programme to successfully reach both M10 and M11 respectively.

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The plan outlines what the activities are, along with when they are expected to take place, who the responsible parties are, the declaration requirements that participants will be expected to follow and the key dependencies that may impact particular activities.
