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Data approach for REC Performance Assurance

The MHHS Programme is introducing changes to industry processes which will have an impact on what and how information passes through new and existing roles.

Highlighted areas that will be impacted are:

- DTN Flows - Replaced with IF flows or amended to accommodate the changes to market roles
- REC Schedules - Reflects changes in process timelines, flows used and amended roles involved

The Code Manager raised an agenda item at the DNO Commercial Operations Group (COG) to introduce our approach to data for the areas impacted. The Code Manager has arranged to host a meeting on **23 May 2024** at 15:00 to further discuss the proposals with a wider audience of (i)DNO representatives.

The meeting will focus on proposals for:

- Meter Asset Installation / Removal / Exchange
- Switching MTDs (Advanced and Traditional Meters Only)

Electralink Data Transfer Service (DTS) Changes

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To support the MHHS Programme's System's Integration Testing (SIT) phase, there was an extraordinary release of the Data Transfer Catalogue (DTC) v14.2 on the Data Transfer Network (DTN) on 13 May 2024.

All DTN users must update the Catalogue in their systems, regardless of their involvement in MHHS testing. Please note that this Catalogue does not include any change to the Operational flows.

Only MHHS SIT participants will need to make material changes to their systems in response to this Catalogue update. Programme participants who are not participating in MHHS SIT will not need to make any material system changes in response to this Catalogue update.

We advise you to make your own independent checks by reviewing the information held on the [REC Portal](#) and the [Digital Navigator](#), and to update your systems accordingly.

ServiceNow Upgrade

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ServiceNow will be upgrading on **28 May 2024** (20:45 – 23:00). The changes in this Release include cosmetic changes such as the DCC branding changing to ServiceNow colours and is **not** focused on deploying new functionality.

ServiceNow will still be available during the upgrade, however only essential activity is recommended during the time window. If a user is logged in during the upgrade, the user might need to log back in following the update. In addition, if a user is in the process of adding a comment to an incident, they might need to re-submit the comment and save when the page is upgraded.
