RESPONSES TO QUESTIONS – FEBRUARY 2023 (3.3.0) REC RELEASE DROP-IN SESSION

1 EVENT BACKGROUND

The REC Code Manager hosted a webinar on the February 2023 (3.3.0) REC Release, which provided participants with the opportunity to learn about what is in scope of the release, who is impacted and where to find information and support.

2 QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q. Does R0055 only pertain to the Switching Operator notifications or does this cover notifications for outage of the Gas and Electricity Enquiry Services? If not, could you please point us to the notification protocols for planned and non-planned outages of the enquiry services?

A. The scope of R0055 is only for Switching Operator notifications for schedule maintenance. The notice for Electricity Enquiry Service is outlined in the <u>Electricity</u> <u>Enquiry Service Definition</u> under Paragraph 6.5. The notice for the Gas Enquiry Service is outlined in the <u>Gas Enquiry Service Definition</u> in Paragraph 6.6.

Q. Can you provide any further information on DCP 383 for the February release?

A. You can find further information on DCP 383 (Provision for Distributors to Move Meters for Service Alterations) on the <u>DCUSA website</u>. The data specification is due to go live on 24 February 2023, but its effective date will be later than this. Once we have further information on this, it will be shared in the REC Weekly Bulletin and REC Change Bulletin.
